DATE OF INTRODUCTION OF THE THIRD BILL STAMPS

May we solicit information on early use of the "Third Bills"? As Zaluski ("Canada Revenues - Volume 1", page 125) has documented, the contract between the Government of Canada and the British American Bank Note Company for the printing of these stamps was signed on 8 February, 1868. Jarrett ("Standard British North America Catalogue" (1929), page 322) stated that the first stamps made their appearance in that same month. To determine more precisely the date of their introduction, we have examined many dated copies of these stamps and can report early dates as follows:

1 cent - Mr 2 68	7 cent - JY 2 68	40 cent - JU 20 68
2 cent - Sp 16 68	8 cent - MY 20 68	50 cent - MY 15 68
3 cent - FE 16 68	9 cent - JU 16 68	1 dollar - AU 15 68
4 cent - MR 2 68	10 cent - Fe 22 68	2 dollar - Ja 21 71
5 cent - JU 5 68	20 cent - JY 2 68	3 dollar - Jy 7 73
6 cent - AP 1 68	30 cent - Ap 16 68	

Many of the above are clearly not very "early", but are included to provide initial reference dates for each denomination. Apart from the 7 cent, which is on ordinary horizontal wove, all examples are on thin, "pelure" paper, of the type also used for the early 1, 2 and 3 cent large queens.

We should be grateful if members of the Revenue Group would send us information on earlier dates than those shown. Information so provided will be communicated in due course to the Newsletter.

We wish to acknowledge the kindness of Kasimir Bileski, who allowed us to examine a major collection of bill stamps, of which he is the owner.
