


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Dear slogan cancel collector:

Beefs and Bouquets

During the past month I have received positive feedback as well as criticism for recent issues of the *Slogan Box*. Some are saying that the *Slogan Box* has too many pages, is too expensive and lacks good illustrations. Others are saying that the hand stamps are irrelevant to the real study of slogan cancels and should not appear in the *Slogan Box* still others are saying that the hand stamps add variety and are a new, heretofore unexplored area. While all are to be believed as sincere personal preferences, how then do we reconcile these differences in viewpoint?

Request for articles

Letter of John Robertson Re: Quebec Station B

The Station B Universal machine Cancel from Quebec appears to be quite scarce and I have never seen anything written about it. I have three examples in my collection April 28, 1917, December 15 1917 and December 7, 1920 and I have seen one more in the collection of another member. Can anyone give more information and/or come up with earlier or later dates?

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A report on the Coutts Slogan Catalogue by the author.

Since publication of the Coutts Catalogue, research by the Slogan Study Group has been ongoing. One area our Chairman Daniel Rosenblat has carefully looked at is the matter of de-listing some offices which do not appear to exist.

In particular, he examined B-770, B-775, K-25, L-230 and V-110, all of them naming certain offices from which slogans have not been seen nor is there department documentation and/or die proofs to support their existence.

The following list of corrections/additions to the Coutts catalogue reflects changes to the above five as well as reports of many new offices/dates of other slogans heretofore unreported.

Of interest too is N-187. This 1939 Newmarket impression was produced on a Columbia machine and reported by member Doug Lingard. We will await the discovery now of a second copy which may contain the full slogan text.

A word should be said about the more modern slogans. Many of the individual offices, from the

multi-office group, were never identified by Proulx. The Coutts catalogue set about to report these for the first time.

In the post-1953 period, post office documentation and die proofs began to wane and by 1975 records were infrequent and/or non-existent. The remaining source for reports then was from the owners of slogan collections.


With the help of these collectors, missing offices and dates are now being reported to the catalogue publisher. I am grateful to all of the study group members, as well as non-members, for their input.

New reports continue to come in and I expect that a second list of additions will be published in the fall of 1997. By that time, we should have a pretty good handle on slogan usage in Canada.

My earlier thoughts that OCR and jet spray equipment would inject new life into slogan collecting has come to pass. Forty-two new slogans are included in List #1 and new ones are appearing with regularity.

Use was at nine English offices, with MONTREAL using the bilingual version, C-96 - 970-A, reading CANADA HELPS HUNGRY MINDS HUNGRY BODIES LE CANADA COMBAT LA FAIM ET L'IGNORANCE. In 1959 only, MONTREAL used a bilingual die of U-45 - 9758, UNITED NATIONS IS YOUR BUSINESS LES NATIONS-UNIES VOUS CONCERNANT. The usage was in late October, to coincide with what became the usual time of observance of United Nations Day.

In 1960, on the U.N.'s fifteenth anniversary, there was the second mention of the observance of an annual United Nations Day, with the issue of O-35 - 6470, OBSERVE UNITED NATIONS DAY OCTOBER 24 and its French version, C-1460 - 2060, COMMERMOREZ LA JOURNEE DES NATIONS UNIES LE 24 OCTOBRE. The French version was used at MONTREAL and QUEBEC, while the English version was used at the twelve offices listed below. Note that MONTREAL used both versions. The non-separable dies were reissued to the same offices in 1961 and 1962, but at least one die must have been damaged in 1961, since a replacement die, with somewhat thicker lettering, has been seen used at HALIFAX in 1962.





In 1962 T-240 - 9470 was issued, THE WORLD UNITED AGAINST MALARIA THROUGH W.H.O. The initials were those of the World Health Organization, an Agency of the U.N. Proulx states use at 13 offices, but 14 are recorded. MONTREAL and QUEBEC used a French version, L-355 - 5498, L'OMS LIGUE LE MONDE CONTRE LA MALARIA. The initials in the French version are those of *Organisation Mondain de Sante*, the French translation of World Health Organization.



The earliest use began on March 30, and continued through April. Thereafter usage was discontinued, with one unusual exception. VANCOUVER use has been recorded in April, but then reappears from mid July to late October, and may have been continuous from April. Even more oddly, it was then revived again at least in mid-February to mid March of 1963, and has also been recorded in mid-November of that year. This very extended use by one office only is an interesting puzzle.



In 1963 S-2015 - 9150, SUPPORT UNICEF, was issued, together with the bilingual version, A-140 - 89, AIDEZ L'UNICEF SUPPORT UNICEF. The initials stand for United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund, an Agency of the U.N. The English version was issued to eight offices, and the bilingual to MONTREAL and QUEBEC. In this case, MONTREAL did not also use an English version. The English usage was at the following offices.





In 1964 EDMONTON used a proprietary slogan advertising an expansion of United Nations Day to United Nations Week, C-40 - 6472, OBSERVE UNITED NATIONS WEEK OCTOBER 17-24. The die was reissued in 1965.

In 1965 only VANCOUVER used proprietary U-55 - 9763, UNITED NATIONS 20TH ANNIVERSARY 1945-65. Unfortunately, this slogan has not been seen, and therefore cannot be illustrated, but its usage is confirmed.

In 1966 the opening of the World Health Organization's new headquarters in Geneva was commemorated by issue of the multi-office W-225 - 10515 W.H.O. NEW HEADQUARTERS BUILDING GENEVA 1966, together with a French version, O-240 - 6565, O.M.S INAUGURATION DU NOUVEAU SIEGE GENEVE 1966. Proulx states that the English version was issued to fourteen offices, but fifteen have been recorded, and the bilingual issued to MONTREAL, QUEBEC and SHERBROOKE. In this case, MONTREAL did not also use the English version.



The English slogan usage is somewhat peculiar, in that Manitoba, Newfoundland and Prince Edward Island were not represented, and New Brunswick was represented by MONCTON, rather than St. JOHN.



In 1966 only VANCOUVER again used a proprietary S-2015 - 9151, SUPPORT UNICEF HALLOWE'EN CAMPAIGN, combining two events normally observed in October, United Nations Day and Hallowe'en.

Also in 1966 only, OTTAWA used both an English and a French version of a slogan advertising a regional Conference of the International Labor Organization, a U.N. Agency. The English I-30 - 4738, I.L.O. 8TH AMERICAN REGIONAL CONFERENCE, used the initials I.L.O., while the French E-145 - 2300, 8E CONFERENCE REGIONALE AMERICAINE DE L'OIT, used the initials OIT, representing the French translation of the Agency's name, *Organisation Internationale du Travail*.



In 1969 only a bilingual multi-office I-35 - 4740, ILO/OIT - WORLD SOCIAL JUSTICE JUSTICE SOCIALE ET UNIVERSELLE, was issued to commemorate the work of The International Labor Organization, a U.N. Agency. Proulx lists thirteen offices, but eighteen have been recorded or reported, as follows.

In 1970 only a bilingual multi-office slogan C-1245 - 1818, COLONIALISM DECLARATION FREEDOM AND PROGRESS DECLARATION CONTRE LE COLONIALISME, was issued. The wording does not reference the U.N. or an Agency, but the subject matter strongly suggests U.N. sponsorship. Proulx lists 1970-71 use at 12 offices, but 13 have been recorded or reported, and as use was in late December, possibly one of the offices continued use into very early January of 1971, but there certainly was no major 1971 reissue. The using offices are as follows.
