

ESTEVAN / ASSA.



ESTEVAN (pop. 500) is 16 km N of North Dakota in the former District of Assiniboia, a regional administrative district of the North West Territories, now a part of Saskatchewan. It was 235 km SE of Moose Jaw on the Portal Section of the CPR that ran from Moose Jaw to North Portal. The Estevan post office opened in September 1892, and the postmaster during the Map stamp period was Dr. E.H. Scott (1892-1900). The Estevan Squared Circle hammer was used in Period 3 from -/FE 8/97 to -/MY 16/99, and intermittently thereafter until 1903. There are no documented Estevan strikes on Map stamp covers.

GRENFELL / ASSA.



GRENFELL (pop. 350) is in the former District of Assiniboia, a regional administrative district of the North West Territories, now a part of Saskatchewan, 130 km E of Regina on the Canadian Pacific Railway main line that ran from Montreal to Victoria. The Grenfell post office opened in May 1883, and the postmasters during the Map stamp period were Edward Fitzgerald (1891-1899) and Harvey Coy (1899-1912). The Grenfell Squared Circle hammer was used from -/FE 7/95 to -/MY 2/00. There are no documented Grenfell strikes on Map stamp covers.



MAPLE CREEK (pop. 300) is in the former District of Assiniboia, a regional administrative district of the North West Territories, now a part of Saskatchewan, 138 km W of Swift Current and 102 km E of Medicine Hat on the Montreal to Victoria main line of the Canadian Pacific Railway. The Maple Creek post office opened in June 1883, and the postmaster during the Map stamp period was John Dixon (1884-1905). The Maple Creek Squared Circle hammer was used in Period 3 from -/OC 21/96 to -/SP 2/99.



MEDICINE HAT (pop. 800) is on the South Saskatchewan River in the former District of Assiniboia, a regional administrative district of the North-West Territories, now a part of Saskatchewan, 293 km SE of Calgary on the Montreal to Victoria main line of the Canadian Pacific Railway. The Medicine Hat post office opened in June 1883, and the postmaster during the Map stamp period was Francis F. Fatt (1891-1906). The Medicine Hat Squared Circle hammer was proofed on -/JY 28/94 and used in Period 2 from -/JY 10/97 to -/NO 7/99 (on a Map stamp). The handbook documents 23 Medicine Hat strikes on off-cover Map stamps.





MOOSE JAW (pop. 1500) is on Moose Jaw Creek in the former District of Assiniboia, a regional administrative district of the North-West Territories, now a part of Saskatchewan, 66 km W of Regina on the Montreal to Victoria main line of the Canadian Pacific Railway, and the N terminus, 227 km N of Estevan, of the Moose Jaw to Portal (on the North Dakota border) Section of the Canadian Pacific Railway. The Moose Jaw post office opened in June 1883, and the postmasters during the Map stamp period were Charles A. Goss (1889-1900) and John H. Grayson (1900-1907). The Moose Jaw Squared Circle hammer was used with the PM time mark (occasional blanks) from -/OC 25/93 to -/AP 12/00.



Hammer 2 of the Wolseley Squared Circle was used from -/OC 12/95 to -/AP 3/00.



PRINCE·ALBERT / SASK.



PRINCE ALBERT is on the North Saskatchewan River, 150 km N of the Assiniboia border, and the N terminus of the Prince Albert Branch of the Canadian Pacific Railway that ran 417 km N from Regina. The Prince Albert post office opened in January 1879, and the postmaster during the Map stamp period was James F. A. Stull (1898-1907). The Prince Albert Squared Circle was used in Period 3 from -/DE 21/98 to -/JA 4/99 (on a Map stamp). After this date, the hammer was not reported to be used until 1903. There are no documented Prince Albert strikes on Map stamp covers.
