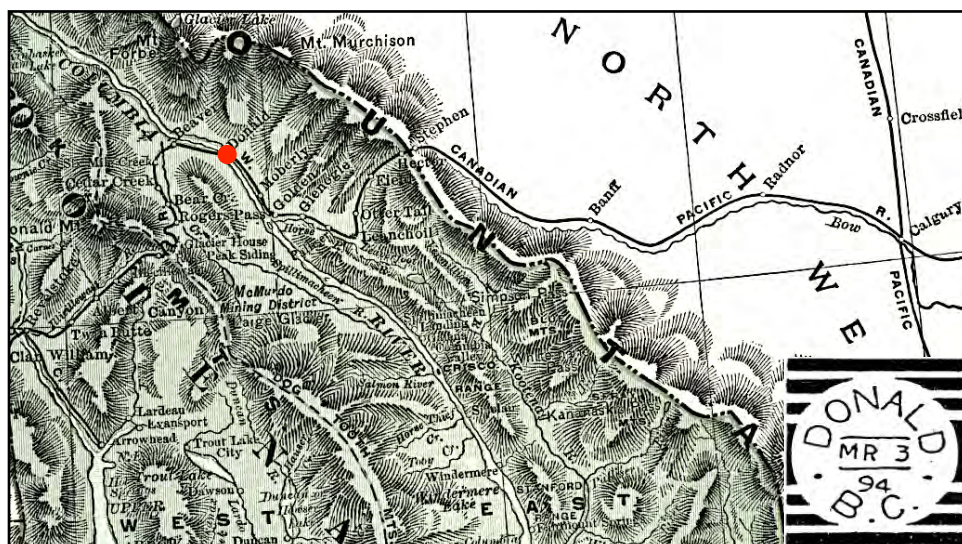

DONALD / B.C.



DONALD (pop. 300) is on the Columbia River, 277 km W of Calgary on the Montreal to Victoria main line of the Canadian Pacific Railway. The Donald post office opened in April 1886, and the postmasters during the Map stamp period were R.W. Patmore (1890-1899) and R.D. Davis (1900-1902). The Donald Squared Circle hammer was used from -/MR 12/94 to -/NO 8/99. The handbook reports 1 Donald cover which has yet to be documented in the philatelic literature.

KAMLOOPS / B.C.

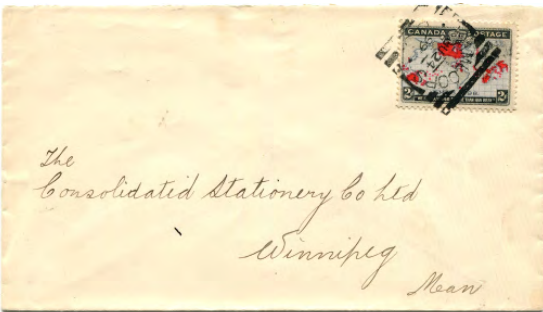


KAMLOOPS (pop. 1000) is on the Thompson River, 140 km W of Sicamous on the Montreal to Victoria main line of the Canadian Pacific Railway. The Kamloops post office opened in July 1871, and the postmasters during the Map stamp period were E.H. Jones (1888-1899) and W.P. Slavin (1899-1912). The Kamloops Squared Circle hammer was used in Period 2 from -/FE 17/99 (on a Map stamp) to -/DE 1/00.

NANAIMO / B.C. (State 2)



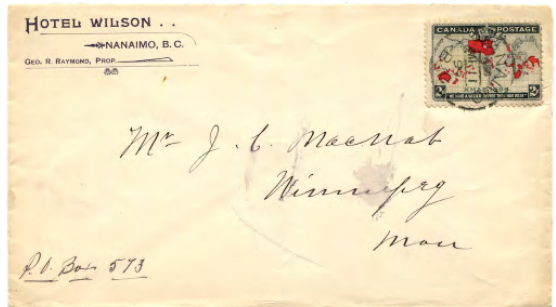
NANAIMO (pop. 4595) is on Vancouver Island, 80 km from Vancouver across the Georgia Strait (ferry connection) and 112 km N of Victoria on the (Victoria to Wellington) Esquimalt & Nanaimo Railway. The Nanaimo post office opened prior to 1872, and the postmaster during the Map stamp period was Adam H. Horne (1890-1928). The first State of the Nanaimo Squared Circle hammer was altered in late DE 1896 to form State 2, a broken circle similar to Schreiber, ONT and Bobcaygeon, ONT. State 2 of the hammer was used in Period 1 from PM/DE 30/96 to AM/MY 14/20. The AM time mark was used during the Map stamp period.

SANDON / B.C.



SANDON (pop. 10,000 est.) is a mining town 170 km SE of Revelstoke and was 47 km from Kaslo on the Kaslo & Slocan Railway. Although it is now a ghost town, at its peak in 1898, it was home to 3 breweries, 29 hotels, 3 churches and 85 brothels! The Sandon post office opened in August 1895, and the postmaster during the Map stamp period was E.R. Atherton (1895-1908). The Sandon Squared Circle hammer was used from -/SP 8/97 to -/JY 28/99. There are no documented Sandon strikes on Map stamp covers.

VICTORIA / B.C. (Hammer 3)

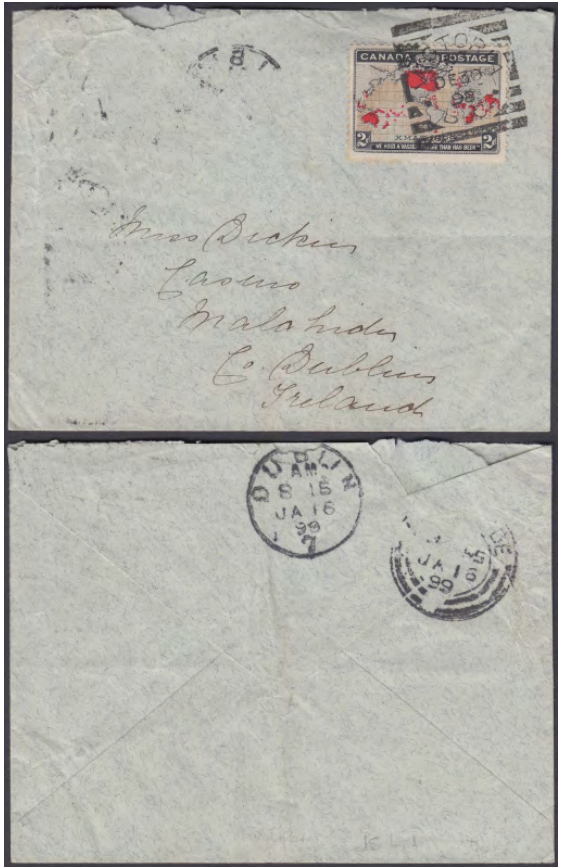


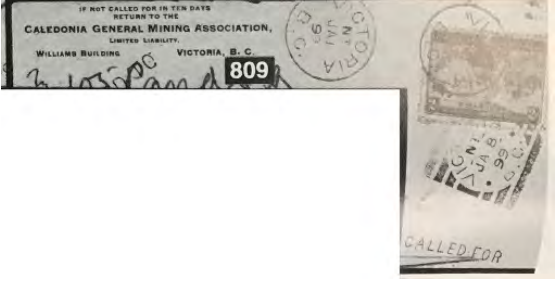
VICTORIA (pop. 16,841) is the provincial capital of British Columbia at the SE tip of Vancouver Island. It is the W terminus of the Montreal to Victoria main line of the Canadian Pacific Railway (via CPR steamer ferry from Vancouver), and the S terminus of the (Victoria to Wellington) Esquimalt & Nanaimo Railway. The Victoria post office opened prior to July 1871, and the postmaster during the Map stamp period was Noah Shakespere (1888-1914). Hammer 3 of the Victoria Squared Circle was used with AM/PM/NT time marks from NT/OC 12/97 to NT/JA 28/00.

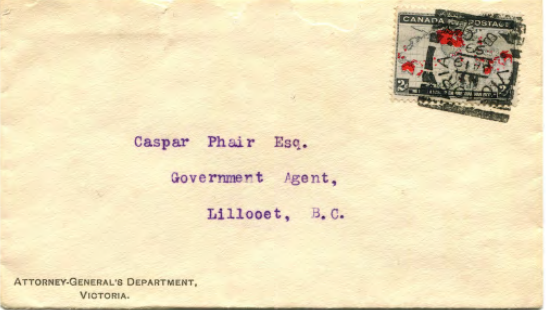
