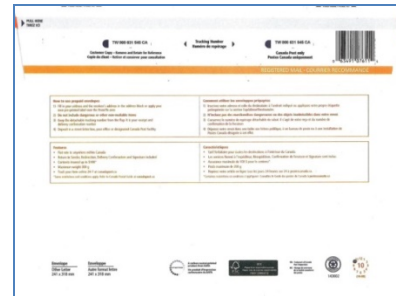

The printed instructions on the envelopes say “Deposit in a street letter box, post office or designated Canada Post Facility.” This was certainly not the traditional Registered Mail, and tracking is already available on Prepaid Xpresspost and Priority.

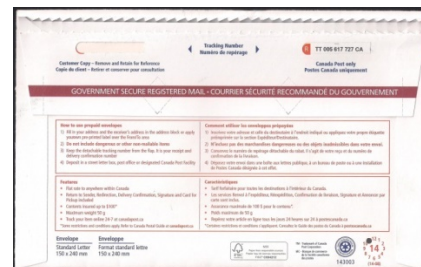

These envelopes were issued in 2 sizes: - The ENVELOPE & later the LETTER - 307 x 229mm.
The PACK - 398 x 306mm.

The regular issue PREPAID PRIORITY POST/COURIER envelopes were paper/cardboard. There were earlier paper as well as plastic envelopes which were not prepaid. These NON-PREPAID envelopes are not listed. The form numbers, issue dates and phone numbers were on the back of the envelopes. There are many differences between the various issues. **We only list enough of the differences to distinguish the individual issues.**

The basic envelope colours were orange and blue with a coloured stripe on the bottom of the envelope depending on the different types of usage. The usages and colours are as follows: -

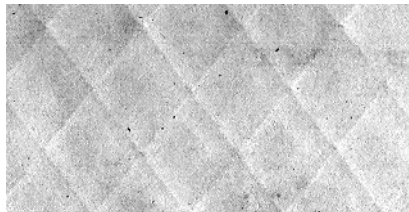
- REGIONAL (for use within a region in Canada) - purple
- OVERNIGHT later NATIONAL (for use outside the region to other serviced regions within Canada) - blue and later silver
- USA (for use to the USA) - brown
- EUROPE (for use to Europe) - green
- PACIFIC (for use to Pacific Rim countries) - turquoise
- INTERNATIONAL (for use elsewhere in the world) - green

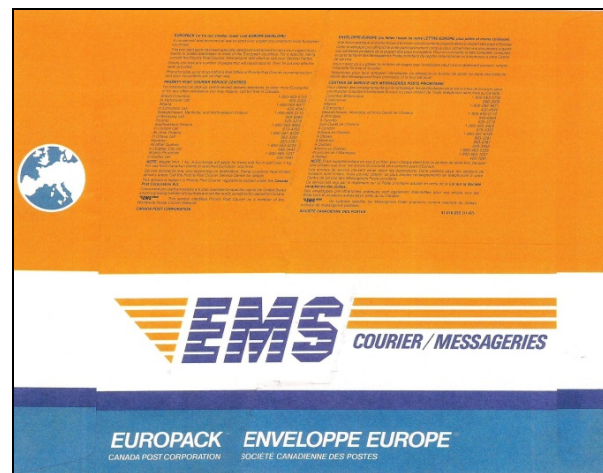

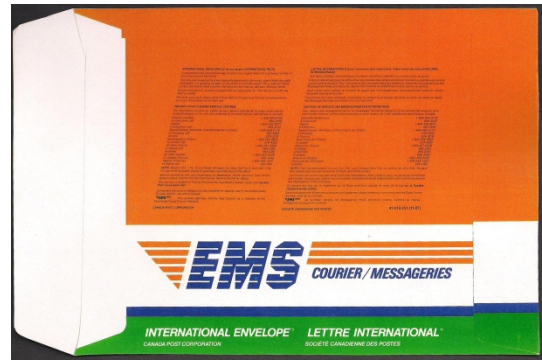

NOVEMBER 1987 ISSUE (Form number and date 11-87)

Format changed to “EMS COURIER/MESSAGERIES.” “CANADA POST CORPORATION” on the bottom line. The INTERNATIONAL ENVELOPE and PACK in error spelt the French title “INTERNATIONAL^{MC}” instead of “INTERNATIONALE^{MC}.” After being on sale for three days these ENVELOPES and PACKS were withdrawn and reissued with a self-adhesive parallelogram with a “_” over the base of the “L” plus the missing “E” and finally a superscript “^{MC}” in a circle. The self-adhesive label covered the error. The error can be manufactured by removing the label and any signs of the adhesive.

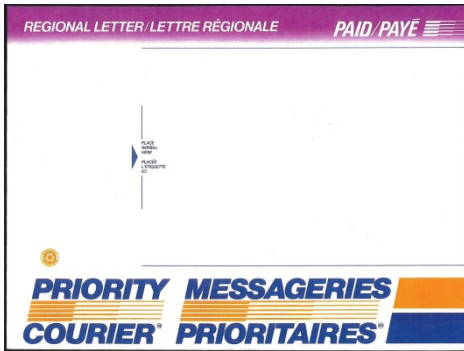
The Post Office was unable to meet the demand for REGIONAL and NATIONAL PACKS. Self-adhesive labels were sold to be applied to free or "Courtesy" plastic PACKS, to be used as the prepaid packs. They were valid only until March 1, 1990 and could be exchanged for PACKS until April 1, 1990. Thereafter they had no value. Sold in vertical strips of four. Prices are for a single label. Labels properly used on plastic packs are worth more.

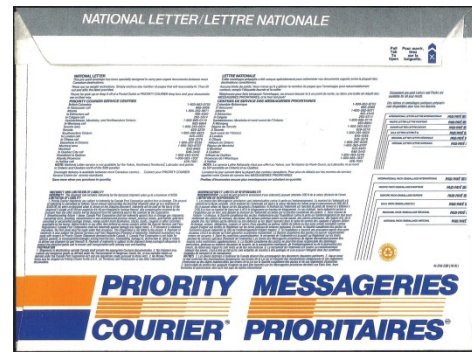

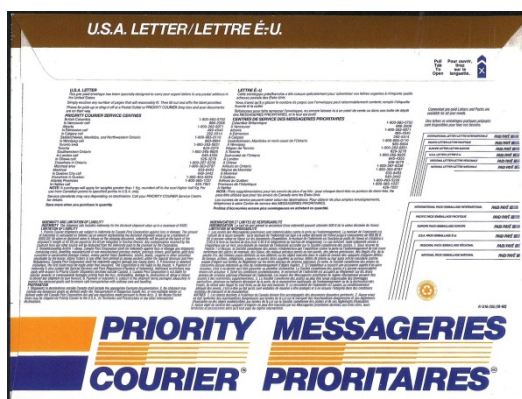
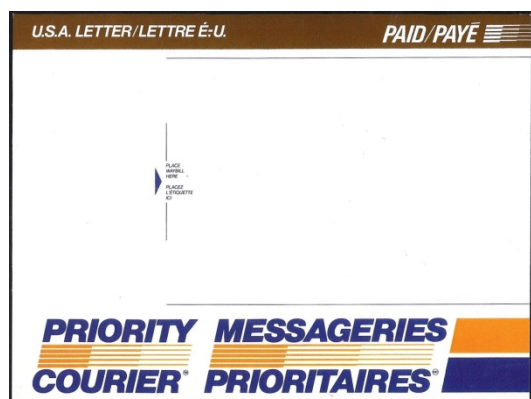

HIDDEN NUMBERS

During this issue hidden printer's or docket numbers and dates appeared. These can be seen using a bright light behind the PACKS. The numbers are located at various points on the PACK. On the LETTERS the numbers can only be seen by carefully opening the side flaps. In some cases, it is not possible to find the hidden numbers on the LETTERS without literally destroying the LETTER. The dates may be under the glued seams and it is impossible to open the LETTER and see the number.

WE DO **NOT** LIST THESE (BUT NOTE THEY EXIST) AS THEY ARE BEYOND THE SCOPE OF THIS CATALOGUE.

Up to this point, there was only one hidden number on each item. Beginning with PP140 there is a second set of hidden numbers on the LETTER size items. The number under the flap is repeated in dark purple and blue (SP14241) on the NATIONAL and in orange, grey and blue (SP14242) on the REGIONAL. Sometimes there is "A A A" or "B B B" in the same colours under the other side flap. IT USUALLY REQUIRES DESTROYING THE ENVELOPE TO FIND THEM. However, there are numbers (**much easier to find**) which are located inside the back of the envelope in varying sizes of black dot matrix type in the following form DD/MM/YY HH:MiMi J#XXXXX where DD = Day, MM = Month (01 to 12), YY = last two digits of the year, HH= Hour, MiMi = Minute, and XXXXX= a number. The DD/MM/YY appear to be at the most on 2 consecutive days, sometimes spread over the entire 24 hour period.

NO ATTEMPT IS MADE TO LIST THE DIFFERENT DD/HH/YY HR:MI WHICH HAVE BEEN FOUND. WE MERELY NOTE THEY EXIST.

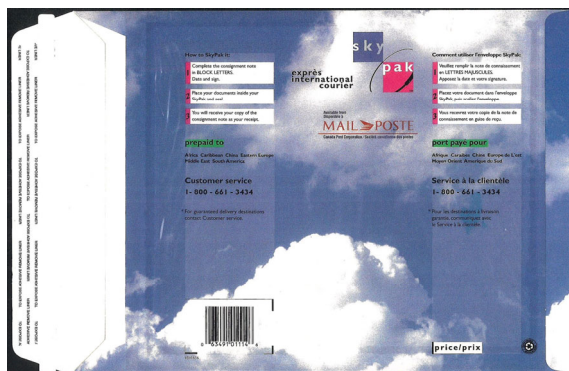
