The second edition of The Air Mails of Canada and Newfoundland (AMCN2) includes:

- Updated listings of Pioneer, Semi-official, Post Office, Airline, and Special Event covers
- additional information on air mail rates, air letter forms, pilot signatures and much more
- guides to information that was not repeated from the First edition of AMCN but is now available on the AAMS website.

**Price:** \$65 + \$10 postage to anywhere (\$ Canadian)

AMCN2 is volume 4 in the Seventh Edition of the American Air Mail Catalogue.

The AAMS has set a price of \$50 US for AMCN2, in order to make it available at an appealing price to many collectors. The Canadian Aerophilatelic Society is matching this price, and selling the catalogue for \$65 Canadian.

In keeping with the objective of making the catalogue available at an appealing price, the CAS will also be matching the AAMS charge for postage within the USA, and shipping copies at a flat rate of \$10 to anywhere in Canada. This rate will also apply to overseas members of the CAS, and other collectors and libraries overseas that are interested in Canadian air mail. (This is possible thanks to a donation the CAS was given a while ago to encourage and promote the collecting of Canadian air mail.)
