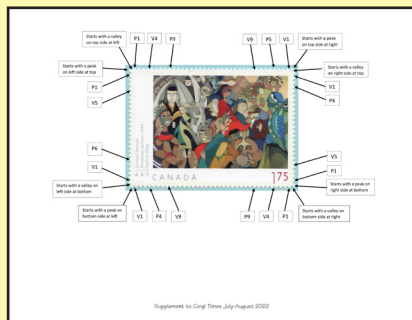

Picture Postage program update

After careful consideration, Canada Post has decided to wind down its Picture Postage™ offering as of September 1, 2022. The program allows users to create personalized postcards and stamps. While relatively unique when it was introduced in 2000, numerous options are now available online for users to create customized items.



This is a timely change as we continue to focus our efforts on telling powerful Canadian stories through the national stamp program. Our stamp program is uniquely positioned to showcase the important people, places, events, and achievements that have helped shape our country. Telling these stories is a tremendous responsibility, but one we embrace as Canada's postal service.

We thank those who have used the Picture Postage program in the past and will process all requests that meet our guidelines until the program winds down on September 1, 2022.

\$1.30 Counterfeit *From Far and Wide*

The current From Far and Wide \$1.30 stamp is now available in counterfeit form.

As with the Permanent™ counterfeit stamps that we reported in the March-April *Corgi Times*, the quality is extremely good — especially the die cutting. These counterfeits are not tagged. One other tell-tale difference is the missing “nibs” on the counterfeit stamps.

Although the counterfeits do not have the characteristic underprinting, they do have the backprinting indicating the number of stamps left in the roll.

The counterfeits are reportedly printed in China.

Shown at right are 600dpi scans of the counterfeit (top) vs. genuine version (bottom).

- Indigenous Leaders

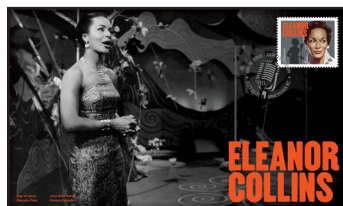

Canada Post Misses?

❶ Our lead story in this issue is with regards to Canada Post cancelling the **Picture Postage™** product. This was first introduced in 2000 at the Royal*2000*Royale show held in Winnipeg, MB. [Coincidentally, my parents were the first public individuals to have their picture taken for the rollout!]

I am actually surprised by this cancellation announcement. I thought that Picture Postage was a very popular item provided by Canada Post. I must be mistaken. I seem to see new offerings of Picture Postage quite often. In thinking about this further, what I see only really come from fellow stamp collectors/societies/club shows. Perhaps Picture Postage is not really popular with the general public? And maybe the answer goes deeper ... maybe the general public is just now using the mail as often as they once did.

Perhaps the cancellation of Picture Postage is not a 'miss', but rather the closure of a not-so-cost-effective, seldom used Canada Post product. Too bad.

❷ Another 'miss' seems to be the lack of a **UPC barcode** on the recently released Vintage Carousels postcards (July 21). Isn't the purpose of these prepaid postcards to get them into the hands of the general public across the country? The lack of a barcode implies that they cannot be sold at a retail outlet. With that said, only 1,000 sets were printed – that amount will not go far in a general distribution across the country. Too bad.

❸ A clear miss on Canada Post's part though, was the lack of a stamp issue acknowledging the visit by **Pope Francis** to Canada from July 24 to July 29, with stops in the provinces of Alberta and Quebec and the territory of Nunavut. A precedence had been set – two stamps were released for the visit by Pope John Paul II to Canada in 1984.

I suspect that the timeframe between the announcement of a Papal visit (May) to the visit itself (late July) was too short for a stamp(s) to be designed, printed and distributed. Too bad.

Canadian Stamp Printers – Down to Two!

At a Canada Post seminar held on the opening day (June 9) of CAPEX 22 in Toronto, a member of the public asked Canada Post a question: "How many printers of stamps are there in Canada?". The answer given was "two".

I raised my hand and pointed out there were three printers: Canadian Bank Note, Colour Innovations, and Lowe-Martin. Canada Post quickly replied, "No, we have only two."

So, of the three printers who have supplied stamps over the years, which one will no longer be printing stamps for Canada Post? An answer was not given during the seminar.

Since Colour Innovations was in attendance at CAPEX, one would think that they will be continuing to print stamps for Canada in the future. Since Lowe-Martin is the only supplier of coil stamps in Canada, one would think they will still be supplying stamps. So, perhaps it is Canadian Bank Note that will no longer be printing Canadian stamps, even though they are the only Canadian printer that supplies engraved stamps. Hmm?

Articles Urgently Needed

Canada Post UPC Barcodes

Canada Post introduced UPC barcodes on their products back in 1989. The first (“00001”) was included on the 39¢ Flag over Clouds booklet pane of 10 stamps (illustrated at right).

I noticed recently that the UPC barcodes passed the “10000” number. I was curious as to what product item had this specific code. As I was creating a database of the items over the last year or two, I noticed that the assignment of barcode numbers was ‘interesting’.

I had expected a group of numbers being assigned to a stamp issue in direct relation to the stamp’s issue date. However, as will be seen by close examination of the following table, it seems as though some (perhaps all?) of the barcode numbers are assigned at the time the product is being conceived/ approved at the design/production stage. This is particularly noticed with the stamp issues that were announced for release in 2020/21 but delayed to 2022 due to the pandemic years. In these cases, the barcode numbers were assigned year(s) ago, well before the stamps were released.

In the table that follows, there are ‘missing’ barcode numbers. Is this due to unassigned numbers, a cancellation in a product that “might have been”, or a number assigned to some other Canada Post product that I am unfamiliar with (I suspect the latter).

Note that my search for the ‘10000’ number was not successful. I was able to find ‘09998’ and ‘10001’ on stamp products (interesting that the two items were issued over one year apart).

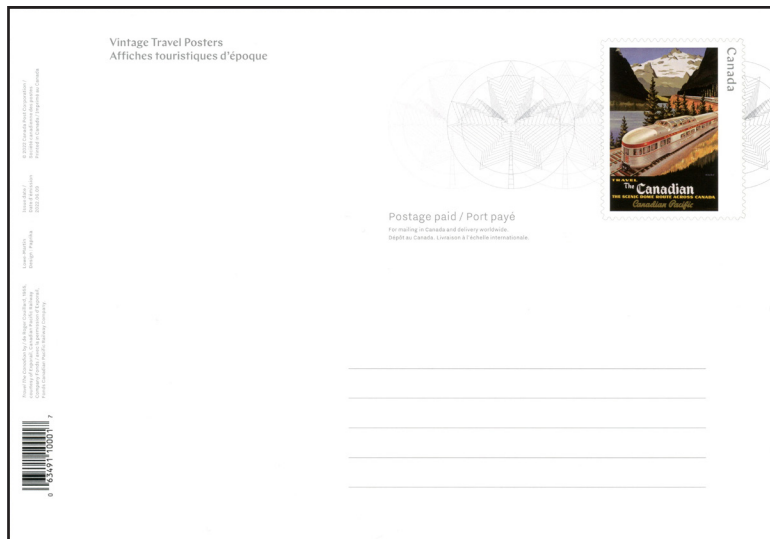

In the early 2000's we became accustomed to annual rate increases by Canada Post. These rate changes, in combination with a declining use of postage stamps on mail, make it a challenge to find many of the rates for registered mail and/or oversized lettermail. Here are three different rates used over a three year period using the \$5 Moose stamp issued in 2003 (Scott 1698).



June 7, 2004

\$6.98 total = \$6.00 registered mail + .98 for lettermail up to 100g



April 29, 2005

\$7.25 total = \$6.25 registered mail + \$1.00 for lettermail up to 100g



May 31, 2006

\$7.55 total = \$6.50 registered mail + \$1.05 for lettermail up to 100g

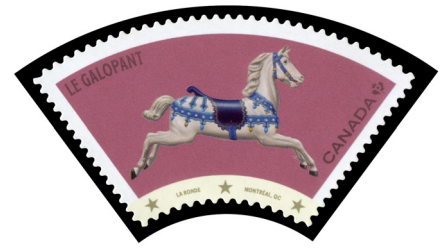
Vintage Carousels

On July 21, 2022 Canada Post issued five designs featuring Vintage Carousels. A self-adhesive booklet of 10, water-activated gum souvenir sheet of five and a set of five postcards were released. A couple of “problems” have been noticed with this stamp issue.

Booklet – Doubling

Doubling in the lettering on two of the stamps from the booklet pane have been reported. This affects the name of the carousel as well as ‘Canada’ and the Permanent™ logo.



Souvenir Sheets

Have you noticed that your circular souvenir sheets are not trimmed correctly around the entire edge? There is a ‘bump’ at one spot around the edge (towards the bottom).

A second “problem” with the souvenir sheet is the very, very narrow selvedge surrounding the outer edge of the stamps. It is nearly impossible to remove this outer selvedge without damaging at least one perforation on the stamp itself.

Postcards – Issue Date and Barcode

A set of five postcards were included as part of the release of these stamps. In recent years Canada Post has been printing the issue date on the postcard itself. Unfortunately, the postcards for this issue show an incorrect release date of 2022.07.08.

A second “problem” with the postcards is that they do not include the customary UPC barcode. The packaged set also does not include the barcode. Since the point of sale terminals in all Canada Post outlets use the barcode at time of purchase, the lack of the barcode implies that these postcards are *not* being sold via retail outlets. If that is the case, then (essentially) only stamp collectors will be purchasing these cards and virtually none will be used by the general public. In which case, why issue postcards at all?

For the record, Canada Post’s online store (and packaging label) shows a printing quantity of only 1,000 sets of postcards.



CAPEX 22 Souvenirs

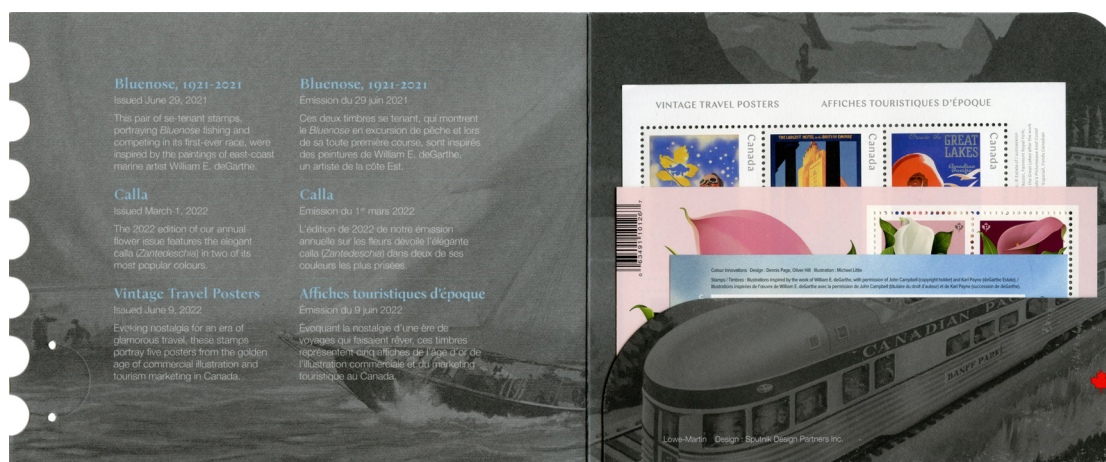

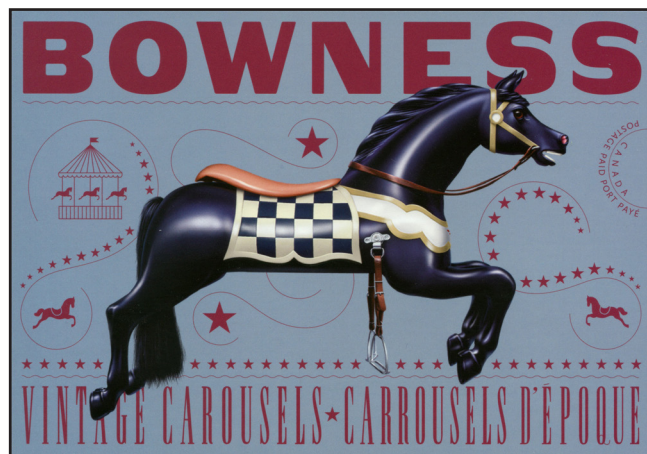
