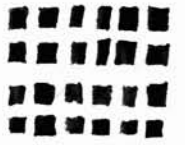

Herewith Cancel Sheet No.5. As far as the photography goes, I think that it is about the best so far. Still have a few tracings on hand, but more are needed to complete Sheet No.6. Is it possible that you owe me some? Would like to see some Parcel Post Cancels, particularly of Halifax and St.John,N.B.

Making tracings is hard, slow and tedious work, but apparently it is necessary - we experimented with photos of the actual stamps and found that in most cases the cancel just did not show. Accuracy in making tracings is essential - in a few instances where I have been able to check, have found that some were not so good. A few sent to me seem to be identical with ones allready listed in Jarrett. Remember also that heavy or light impressions, little or too much ink etc. will tend to make some of these "corks" look different.

Jarrett's Standard Catalogue, 1929, is our "Bible" and in order to follow his method of listing, we need - the place of use, date of use and the denomination of the stamps noted on. Sometimes the place of use is impossible to determine, sometimes the date of use will have to be a guess, but you should always be able to report the denomination of the stamp noted on.

I am glad to note that some of the cancels on the earlier sheets are now being identified as to place of use. This is going to be a big problem. Another is the final re-sorting, regrouping and renumbering of the finished product. And then the final results will have to be published. This may take some money, and although I have said several times that I was not seeking financial assistance, would like to say that mimeographing and mailing Cancel Sheets Nos.1 to 5 has cost over \$40. and has been covered by the donations of Messrs. Binks, T.E.Boggs, Grimmer, Hedley, White, and Blois.
