- (1) Would study group members please report what 4-ring cancels they have on the 3¢ S.Q. (On or off cover.)
- (2) What 2-ring numerals they have on the 3¢, both on and off cover, and with dates if possible for the cover examples.
- (3) Would members be good enough to report on the VERY THICK PAPER variety appearing as early as December 20, 1870 (cover reported by Art Leggatt). This variety is reported from the following post offices: Toronto, Hamilton, Brantford, Quebec, Ayr, Ingersoll, Aylmer, Kincardine, New Carlisle, Frankfort, St. Catherines, Belleville, Goderich, Sherbrooke, London, Kingston Cross, Elora. Please note if you have it from any other post office so that we my update the above list.
- (4) Urgently require precise reports on the perf 12½ of January to October 1870. I have recorded at least two different printings of this stamp, and possibly three. Does anyone have a dated cover or single with the Rose-tinged shade? I have two off cover but undated. I notice that in March the colour of the perf 12½ goes to a much paler copper shade than the Indian Red of January February. I have a cover from August which has a very strong copper shade. The following perf combinations are also on hand: 12.35 x 12.4, 12.4 x 12.4, 12.4 x 12.35, 12.55 % 12.4, 12.45 x 12.4. What do you have to report?
