
AMERIPEX REPORT

As those of you who attended AMERIPEX know, it was an absolutely overwhelming stamp show. The exhibits were extremely powerful. There were lots of dealers with good stocks and postal agencies for the new issue collectors. The youth programs were most encouraging for the future of the hobby. And there were plenty of visitors, even during mid-week when I was there. However in my opinion, the quantity and quality of the BNA exhibits was not up to the level of the rest of the show. For the Newfoundland collector there were no competitive exhibits—a major disappointment. The only Newfoundland on display were Robert

Pratt's pence issues in the Court of Honor and parts of other exhibits such as John Foxbridge's BNA first issues and Paul Dinger's Dornier DO-X. I certainly hope the reason for BNA's poor showing was exhibitors holding back their exhibits in anticipation of CAPEX next year in Toronto.

I was only able to spend two full days at AMERIPEX which was just time to see the BNA and a few other exhibits, visit with friends, and check out a few dealers. I went to Chicago knowing that two dealers were each bringing an unusual Newfoundland item to the show. To my amazement, on the eighth day of the show, both dealers had the respective items available. Both items are now in my collection. A photocopy of one is included with this newsletter; more about the other in a future newsletter. The fact that these items were still available so late in the show only reinforces my suspicions that there is a lot of good Newfoundland out there waiting to be made into great collections.
