-Dates are listed thusly; month/day/year.

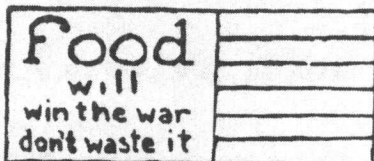

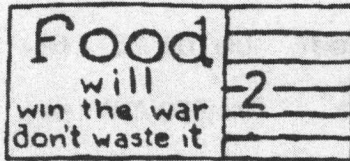

SC1 "Food will win the war Don't waste it"



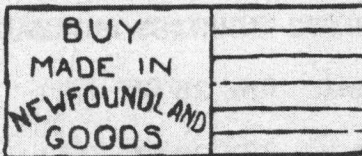

SC2 "Food will win the war Don't waste it - '2' "



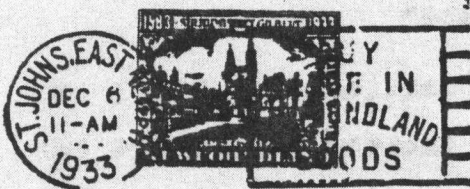

SC3 "BUY MADE IN NEWFOUNDLAND GOODS"



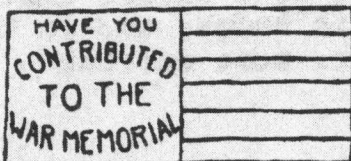

SC3a "BUY MADE IN NEWFOUNDLAND GOODS" - St. John's East



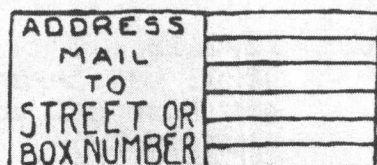

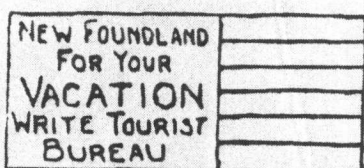
SC5 "ADDRESS MAIL TO STREET AND BOX NUMBER"

SC7 "BRITISH EMPIRE EXHIBITION 1924"

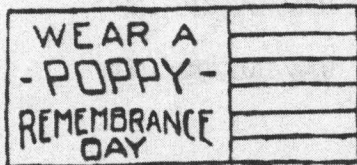

SC8 "WEAR A POPPY REMEMBRANCE DAY"



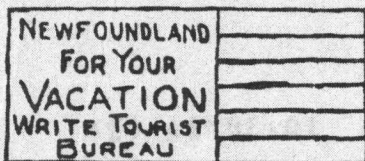

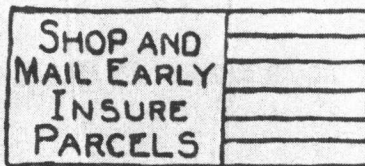

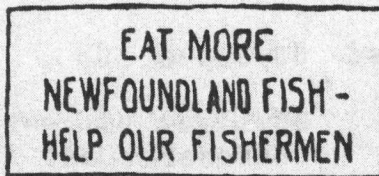

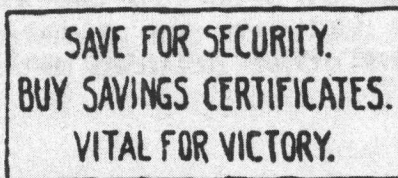

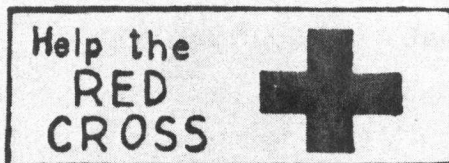
