The cover, dated Aug 7, 1928, complete with its contents still intact, was sent from a St. John's stamp dealer to a customer in New Westminster, B.C. The letter inside identifies the dealer by the name of R.C. Rose. R.C. Rose advises the customer to stock up on the 'new Pictorials' as a nice investment.

R.C. Rose's letter has a letterhead "The Newfoundland Stamp Collector" and advises 'Subscription 25c Year" and "Advert. Rate \$2.00 Page". This implies newsletters were distributed to subscribers.....has anyone seen any of these?

Also enclosed is a subscription form for "The Stamp Collector's Magazine" (One year subscription at \$1.00 nice price). This subscription form is endorsed by the 'Newfoundland Stamp Exchange" same address as The Newfoundland Stamp Collector.

Nice item on the cover is the Scott Specialized Cat No. 147, 3c with LATHEWORK. 14c paid the registered fee to B.C.

Now I know why covers are so interesting !!!!!!



FIRST PROVISIONAL COVER - EARLY DATE OR CLERK ERROR?


Pictured is what appears to be an "Oc 5 97" cover with the first provisional, SCOTT #75 (NSSC #69) postmarked at St. John's Central. As I pointed out in my article in the May/June issue, the first recognized issue date for the first provisionals is October 19, 1897. This cover, purchased in an April Maresch auction, poses a question then - is October 5, 1897 the real first day of usage?

The earliest cover I had from St. John's Central (before buying the instant cover) was November first. Most of the provisionals were sold at the G.P.O., and as far as I know, all October 19, 1897 covers are from the G.P.O. I don't know when the stamps were first sold at the Central office. From Dean Mario, we know the PAID ALL covers start on Sept. 24, 1897, but he has none between October 2nd and the 12th. The Cabot 1¢ stamp ran out towards the end of September, so what was used between the 2nd and the 12th?

There is a good chance that this cover resulted from a error by a postal clerk at the Central office. It could be that the hammer was not updated with the "NO" slug, and actual postmarked date should have been "NO 5". Another possibility was that the date should have been "OC 25".

Once again, I would appreciate any help you could provide. Also, I am still looking for "new" usage dates for the first provisionals per my chart from the last issue of the newsletter.


