MESSAGE FROM THE STUDY GROUP CHAIRMAN

As you are reviewing this first edition of the BNA Perforator I assume that you have some interest in Canadian perfins. The primary function of the BNAPS Perfin Study Group is to inform collectors and specialists of new or interesting aspects within Canadian perfins. I suspect that once you are aware of some of the lesser known facets of perfins you will begin to notice things in your collections that had not stood out before and will check the companies in your area that had, or are still, using perforators. The background of the use of perfins and the perforators are not all the same and many of the perforators still exist abandoned in basement corners. In the past two years perforators that ceased use in the late 1930's and early 1940's have been located, usually the companies aware of the existence of the machines do not know what the perforators had been used for.

One project that is planned to be undertaken by the Study Group as a cohesive group of collectors is to review and update the BNAPS Handbook on perfins and print a new edition when the review is complete. This is not a simple task and will take several years to do properly. The Study Group Executive has come up with a fairly simple, but comprehensive, questionnaire which will tell approximately when a perforator was used, possibly where, and what sort of stamps, revenues, etc. were perforated. The greater number of collectors who participate the greater the accuracy of the results, regardless of the number of perfins each collector has. There are significant differences in collections depending on where, when and for how long the perfins were collected. For those who might be worried, there will be no way to connect a questionnaire with a collector after they have all been received for there will not be any personal reference on them. We trust that the information will be accurate to the best of your ability.

The Executive encourages personal research and will assist where ever possible. The BNA Perforator is available for collectors to ask questions, propose theories and request assistance. When something new, or different, appears you are requested to share your discovery via the Perforator. If there is anything that you would like the Study Group to look into, or if you have recommendations for the direction of the Study Group please state your thoughts. There is no use for the Study Group if it does not assist you in your knowledge of perfins and hopefully in collecting them. The BNA Perforator is planned to be printed monthly so if you have any requests or articles please send them to the Editor and they will see print quickly. As the key is information, even paragraphs of several sentences are deemed valuable as they may start other collectors looking for what you learned or suspect.

I hope that you will participate in the Study Group and that it can assist you in your collecting perfins.

Below is a copy of the Constitution that the study group will follow.

CONSTITUTION

BRITISH NORTH AMERICA PHILATELIC SOCIETY PERFIN STUDY GROUP (1979)

OBJECTIVES:

To update the information in the 3rd Edition of the BNAPS Handbook on Canadian Perfins with the intention of eventually printing a 4th Edition.

To add information to that presently in the Perfins Handbook which is of interest to perfin collectors and other specialty fields.

To provide perfin collectors with a source where answers to Canadian perfin queries or problems may be found.

To promote perfins by assisting collectors in writing articles and perfin postal histories for philatelic journals and newspapers.

Where possible to encourage collectors to exhibit perfins at all levels of philatelic shows.

MEMBERSHIP:

Must be a member in good standing of BNAPS.

ORGANIZATION:

Will have two member Executive - Chairman and Secretary. The members holding Executive positions will be reviewed annually, in September, with positions being confirmed, withdrawn or appointed by a majority of the Study Group members. The Executive have the option of appointing a Newsletter Editor if they deem such a position advisable.

DUES:

Each member upon joining the Study Group will pay an initiation fee of two dollars (\$2.00) Canadian to the Secretary. Annual dues may be set by a majority of the Study Group members to cover expenses incurred by the Study Group (primarily postage). Annual dues will not be set prior to January 1, 1980, so an expenses trend can be established. Dues are not to be set such that an intended credit will be built up in the name of the Study Group.

AFFINITY WITH OTHER PHILATELIC SOCIETIES:

Will be in contact with other Philatelic Societies and their members, in the Study Group's name, to achieve the objectives listed above. The Study Group will accept research assistance from members of other Philatelic Societies. Whenever possible these people will be encouraged to join BNAPS and the Study Group officially.

EXECUTIVE RESPONSIBILITY:

Secretary - control funds held to cover operating expenses and records and files of the Study Group. Both Secretary and Chairman will jointly direct the activity of the Study Group and either may correspond with third parties regarding Study Group business (Secretary to receive a copy of Chairman's correspondence for the files).
