The following note was found among the papers of the late Bob Woolley. While the handwriting has not been confirmed it is thought to be that of Mr. Woolley. To this brief comment and its accompanying illustration 9 have added some further information.

"Irom left to right' as perforated on a stripof ten stamps face up and bottom of sheet aligned so that 'E' will read correctly when the stamp is face up and vertical."

It will be noted that this ten-die machine has many broken pins since being brought into use around 1912, leaving only two dies intact. Dies 7, 9 and 10 are such that examples may be resting in someone's can't identify category, and it is hoped that the illustration will be of assistance.

My own collection consists of four values, Scott #104, 106, 111 and 233 none of which show any missing pins. My records indicate a further twenty-eight stamps, plus three revenues, are known with this design. These encompass all the definitive sets up to the 1949 Geo. VI issues, followed by a scattering of values thereafter. It can be assumed that when pin damage reached a certain level Swift's abandoned use of the perforator. What is not known is either the machine's present location or if the damage was mainly after the machine was taken out of use. It would be of interest to learn what stamps owned by members show damage as depicted in the illustration. With enough feedback it would be possible to plot the deterioration of the dies by date.

# Perfins of the Sun Life Assurance Co. Part 3


The purpose of this third article on Sll perfins is to give you additional tools and clues to identify your Sll types. I realize more than ever the difficulties the general collector has in sorting his holdings. I understand also that with so many similar patterns (95 in total) it is enough to make anybody blind:

However, practice makes perfect!

... at least it is a goal to aim and lets give a try.

The illustration here shows some of the checking points one must have in mind in order to eliminate some of the patterns until the right one seems to be found. Then, by laying your perfin on the printed pattern from my last article, using a lox magnifying glass you can see if the holes match exactly.

Several patterns are similar, so it is only by checking out every caracteristics of your perfin very carefully that you have a chance to identify it positively.



The more you will increase your knowledge on the various types of S11, the prouder you'll be and this great feeling and satisfaction will eventually reflect in your collection.

Following in the next three pages you will find more clues to make you concentrate your efforts on existing records. Example: you have a No. 119 perfined Sll. The survey shows that issue in the Toronto column. Indeed, your chances are good. I found it in five collections all with roller cancel from Toronto. But they are not all that easy. In this survey, I listed only the types and positions seen by me. Many more catalogue numbers exist perforated Sll and I am anxious to list them in this survey, if only I can see them.

#### Sll.1-1, WHAT'S THAT?



In the future, when referring to any type of Sll, it will only be a decimal figure replacing the city of origin, giving us Sll.l for Halifax and when referring to any of the 5 patterns from that perforator, it will be indicated in that manner: Sll.l-l for the first punch from the left, Sll.l-2 for the second, etc.

I hope to stimulate enough interest with this 3rd article to receive more questions, more material to identify and add to my surey of issues and positions and finally more requests for my recent list with 16 types of the Sll, with a good representation of the issues of the 30's offered for sale or trade.
