

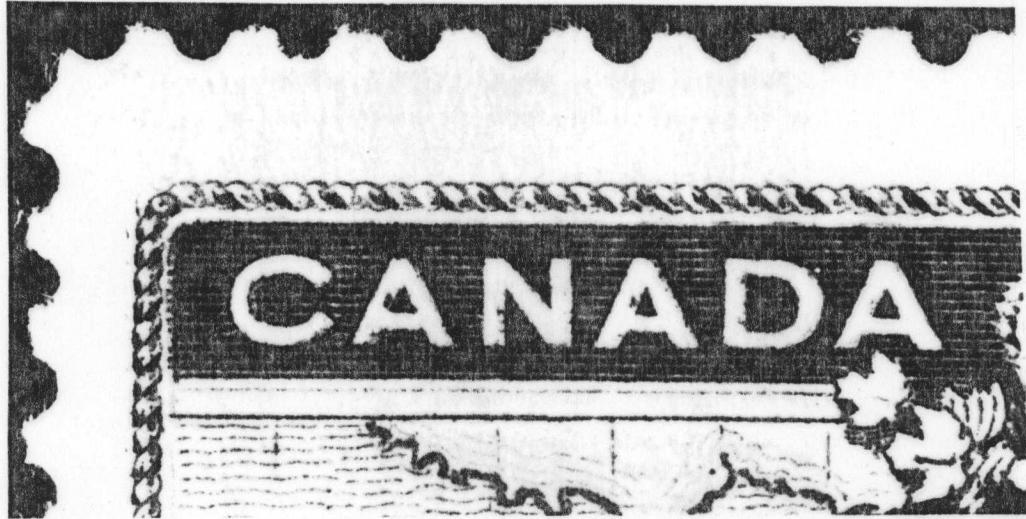

CORRECTION: THE 2¢ S.Q. LATENTS

Following publication of the last article in issue #16, Jan.-Feb. 1985, Vol. 4, No. 1, I came to realize that I had made a serious error in the interpretation of Hans' and Mike's data regarding the 2¢ S.Q. latents.

I would therefore like to clarify the fact that Hans and Mike DO believe that the two latents indeed come from positions one above the other on the plate ! The point of their argument against Hillson's article in issue #13 was NOT in regard to the positions of the latents on the plate, but rather to HOW they were caused !

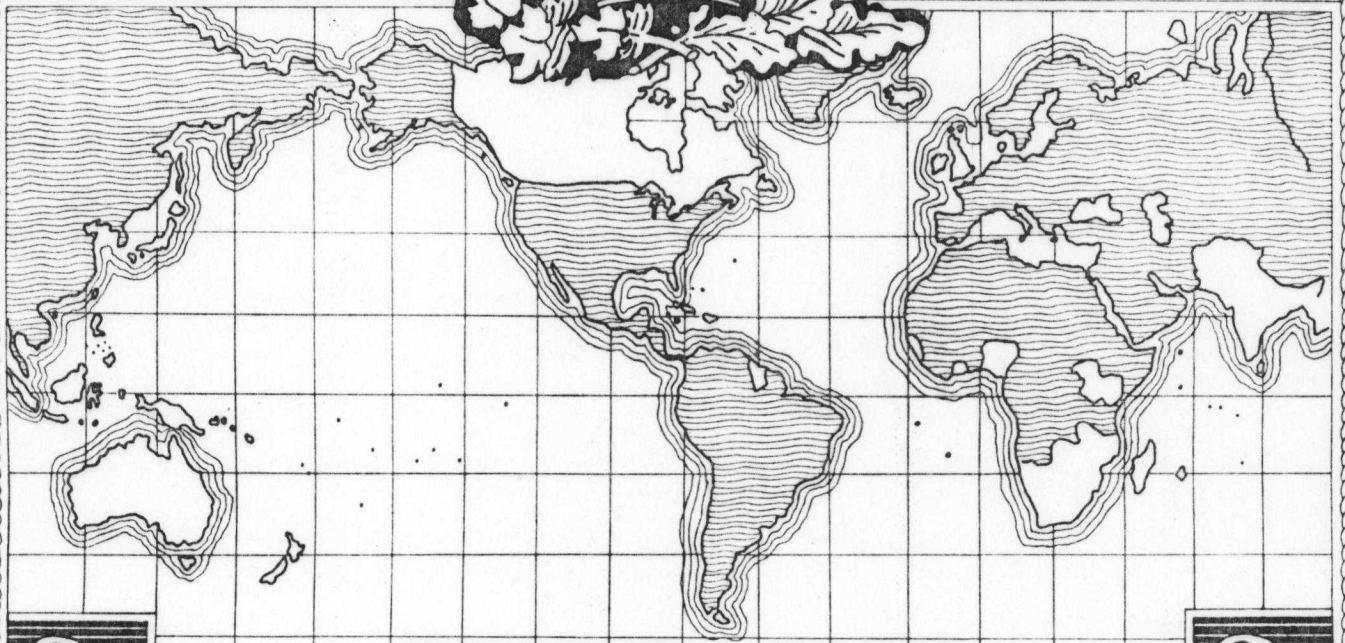
