CANADIAN RE-ENTRY STUDY GROUP

King George VI Peace Issue 1946 Perf. 12

NEW DISCOVERY

Ronny Waldston of North York has discovered re-entries on the Peace Issue similar to the re-entries found on the Peace Issue Airmail stamp C9. Ron was kind enough to send the original stamps for copying, along with his notes. Ron has looked through thousands of copies and has been rewarded for his hard work. Here are Ron's findings:

TWENTY CENT COMBINE CS #271



This stamp shows distinct doubling in the lower left corner horizontal and vertical frame lines (Fig. 1).

There is also doubling in the top right corner, horizontal and vertical frame lines (Fig. 2). Ron has found two examples in 4,000 copies examined. This re-entry is every bit as strong as the C9 major re-entry as listed in *Canada Specialized*.

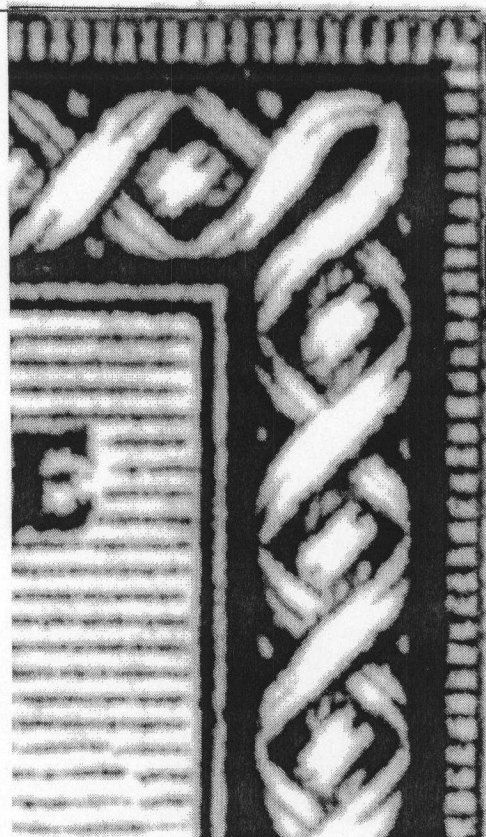

In Figure 3, there is distinct doubling in the lower horizontal frame line, starting in the left corner until the 'E' of 'CENTS'. There were five examples found in 4,000.

There is distinct doubling in the top horizontal frame line starting from the 'N' in 'CANADA' to the right corner (Fig. 4).

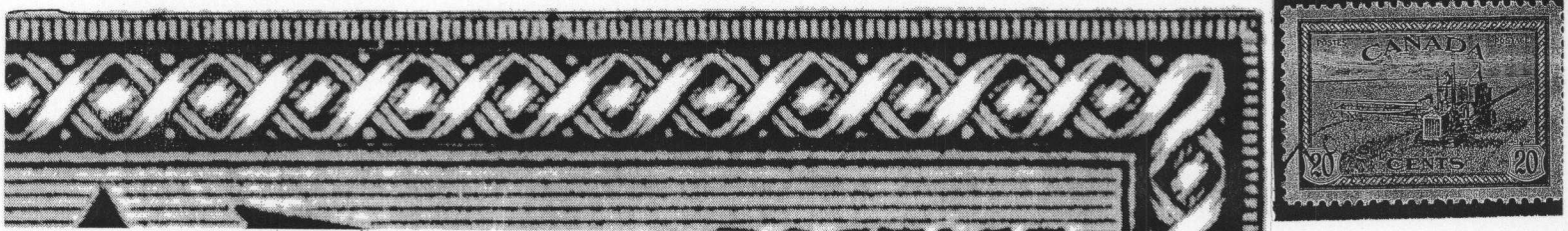

Doubling is not as distinct in the lower frame line below 'CENTS'. Five found in 5,000 copies.

There is distinct doubling in the frame lines in the lower left corner – horizontal and vertical frame lines (Fig. 6)

TEN CENT GREAT BEAR LAKE CS #269



The top left vertical frame line is doubled on this stamp. Ron has found a ratio of about 2 stamps with the re-entry per 1,000 stamps examined.

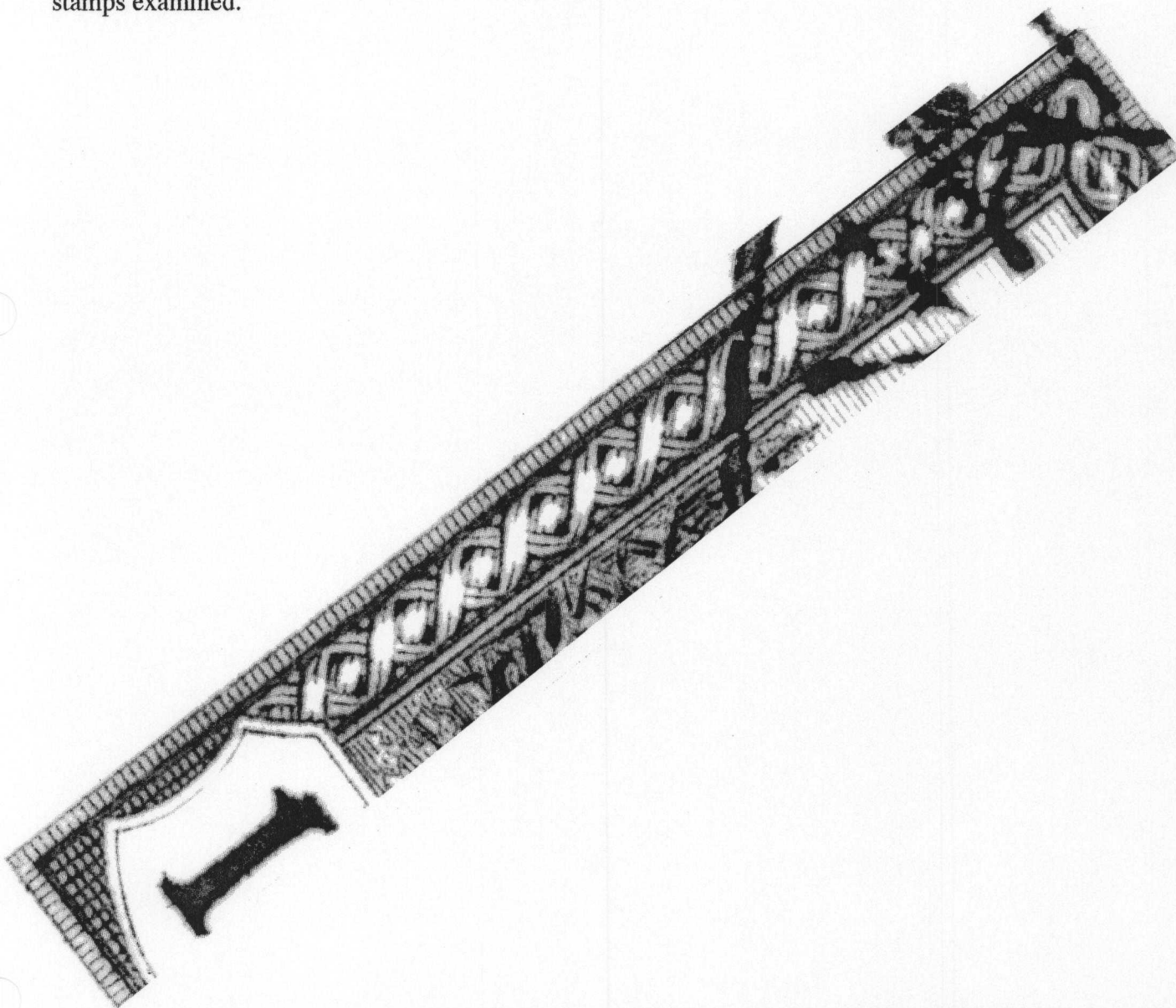

Ron has also found doubling in the left vertical frame line of the 14 Cent Hydro Electric Plant, CS #270. However, it is not defined enough to reproduce here.

Who would have thought that after all these years (the stamps were issued in 1946) that these re-entries existed and no one spotted them until now? Ron – go directly to the Re-Entry Hall of Fame! Thanks for sharing your discovery with the rest of us.

Ron is looking at quantities of the one dollar stamp of this issue CS #273 hoping to find something of interest. Good luck Ron!
