Dual printed surcharge consisting of 3 mm red Gothic letters and figures across top in one line as "4c. EXCISE TAX" and 5 mm red Gothic figures over old value in center. Corner values cancelled with a 4 mm red rosette.

Surcharged with 6 mm red Gothic figures and 3 mm red Gothic letters as "4c. - EXCISE - TAX" in 3 lines. Surcharge is same as M-588 through M-598 except with new rates.







Lithographed, crown at top, beaver at bottom, Garter inscribed "27 & 28 Vict. - Cap. III." Garter appears as a round tube, Customs stamps are blue.

M-700 Port open, unwmk. wove paper, perf. 12½ X 13½


Format similar to above but stamp has been completely redesigned. Garter appears as a belt.

- M-701 Port open, dark blue on pink laid paper with batonne or chain lines 27 mm apart, wmk. "EXCISE" only, perf. 12½
- M-702 Port open, greenish blue on light blue laid paper with batonne lines 27 mm apart, wmk. "EXCISE" only, imperf.
- M-703 Same as above except on laid paper with batonne lines 18 mm apart.
- M-704 Port open, light blue on cream laid paper with batonne lines 27 mm apart, wmk. "EXCISE" only, imperf.
