Surcharged "15" with single lined black figures 16 mm tall with apostrophe "s" after "15". No horizontal bars.

PROVISIONALS

Surcharged on NT-120, "FIFTY - CIGARETTES" in two lines reading up or down. Three slightly different types of printing was noted.

- Type (a) - bars of "F" thin with lower bar longer than top, small serifs.
- Type (b) - bars of "F" about same length, larger serifs.
- Type (c) - lower bar of "F" much shorter and with larger serifs.

Newfoundland 1/10th lb. "CUT TOBACCO" stamp surcharged "FIFTY - CIGARETTES" in two lines reading up or down. Perforated 10-3/4 or 12. Imprint: "BRITISH AMERICAN BANK NOTE CO. OTTAWA", 16 1/2 mm long. The same dies were used for the surcharge on this stamp as those used for the previous issue surcharged "FIFTY CIGARETTES".



It has been reported that the small strip stamps were used on Gem cigarettes, a local manufacturer. Imprint at bottom: "BRITISH AMERICAN BANK NOTE CO. LTD. OTTAWA, CANADA", 24-1/2 mm long and letters have serifs. None were found that were imperforate on both ends which would indicate that they were printed in sheets of 3 or more wide.





Surcharged with black 3 mm printed "20" at ends deleting old values. The "2" on the right "20" is 4½ mm tall.



Several varieties of cancellations were found on the NT-140a, such as Pica "CANCELLED" at top center, center, and lower center with additional upper case letters such as "A. L.", "M. I.", and "Z. I." on the right end. The meaning of these letters is unknown to this collector and it was decided not to try to list all of these minor cancellation differences.


