superseded by the stamps of Canada. Double letters such as QQ 6 indicates a second printing of January, 1946. The letters are found with small single, small double, large single and large double letters. Also, two different styles of the small "Q" were noted. Shown on the previous page are some of the cancellations or overprints that are thought to have been used prior to the initiation of the coded date system.

PROVISIONALS

Surcharged "10 s" in black manuscript. Date code is also black manuscript. None of the surcharged small Caribou stamps were found to be imperforate.

NT-158 No value, blue, imperf., tall size, o/p "Naval-and-Military-Canteens" in four lines.

It is reported that the blue "Military Canteens" were used on Canadian and Newfoundland cigarettes only, beginning in 1941 and ending in early 1945.

PROVISIONALS

NT-158 overprinted with three 4 mm wide bars to delete "Military and Naval Canteens".

NT-159 No value, o/p with three 4 mm RED bars

NT-159a - o/p with three 4 mm BLACK bars

It was noted that some of the bars were not as long as the stamp is wide, that is, there would be a 4 to 6 mm gap at either the right or left edge.

NT-158 surcharged with a 2 mm black printed "20" in addition to the red bars.





NT-173 20 Cigarettes, "20", 4 mm violet handstamped Roman figures, roul 11½, used by Camel

NT-173a - printed 4½ mm thick "20", roul. 11-1/2 - used by Camel

NT-173b - printed 4½ mm thin "20", imperf., used by Camel

NT-174 20 Cigarettes, 6 mm handstamped violet Roman figures, roul 11½ - used by McDonald

NT-175 20 Cigarettes, 4½ mm printed black roman figures, imperf., - used by Lucky Strike

NT-175a - 4½ mm printed black thin "20" Roman figures, imperf. - used by Lucky Strike

NT-176 50 Cigarettes, roul 11½, handstamped red 5 mm "50" - used by Lucky Strike

NT-177 50 Cigarettes, imperf., handstamped 4 mm violet "50", used by Camel


