Watermarks

On NB Tobacco and PEI Health Tax Tickets

By studying a number of watermarked panes, one watermark for the PEI Health Pax Tickets and two watermarks for the NB Tobacco Tax Tickets have been reconstructed in their full size, as shown below. These three are the only ones I am aware of. If other collectors have further information, please write (8 Toronto Drive, Chatham, N. B., Canada ElN 2A3).

1. PEI Health Tax:

Watermark runs vertically across the stamps.



2. N. B. Tobacco Tax

- A. First issue of 28 Sep 1940. Watermark runs horizonally Parallel to the printed words on stamp.
- B. Second issue of 3 Dec 1940 and third issue of 15 Feb 1941. watermark runs vertically across the stamps.
