
The small 5 cigar stamps from Benson & Hedges (34-10D) used a numeral onth/year combination i.e. 5-0 or 5-1 for May 1960 and 1961 but then switched o a alphabetic coding PY-C; PP-C; PA-C. If they kept to their numerical system his should be month/year with P for 1, A for 2, and Y for 0, to give 10, 11 nd 12 (Oct/Nov/Dec). My most complete year is C-K, D-K, E-K, G-K, I-K, K-K, -K, P-K, PA-K, PP-K. From other years I can add A-K and PY-K (which I haven't et located). In 1965 or 66 they went to the small black 5 cigar stamp at E-G, -G, and PP-G so G should be 5 or 6. For Year Codes, I have A, I, K, N, C, and (2,3,4,5,6?). It's like the New York times Sunday Crossword dragged out over any years. I feel it is a ten letter code word (0 to 9) but I just haven't een able to figure it out - something like PAGICKENDY - which makes no sense. Ay it is a lot of fun and somewhat of a puzzle. What I require is to fill in he years. There are now 54 different in the 6 years. Then to complicate verything I have come up with A-B in both the imperf and perf varities. B just oesn't fit anything. Mayhaps I am on the wrong track, or is B a printer's rror?
