

TWO DIFFERENT CLERK STRIKES ON A COVER - Allan Steinhart sends this interesting cover with clear strikes of - Q-46Ag, LEVIS & MONT. R.P.O./ J.O.R.ROY, in blue, and Q-120Db, MONT.& NORTH BAY, R.P.O./ W.T.BURKE, in purple, along with strikes of regular R.P.O.s - MA-23, MA-71, and 0-192. Dates range from May 21 to 23, 1928.

This report necessitates a change in the listing for Q-46Ag, which was originally reported by Graham Noble as J.O.ROY. Note the third initial. The correction will appear in Annex 15. Thanks, Allan !




MA-80 Hmr III HALIFAX & CAMP. R.P.O. 1, JUN 20, 51 on a \clubsuit c postal stationery envelope addressed to Fredericton, N.B. Previously the latest reported date for this hammer was 06/18/37.

MA-115 Hmr II HALIFAX & ST. JOHN / M.C. W, OC 3, 95

on a post card addressed to Philadelphia, Pa. The earliest date previously reported was 11/26/95.







MA-116 Hmr III HALIFAX & ST. JOHN R.P.O. W, MY 21, 20 as a transit backstamp on a registered cover from ELMDALE, N.S. to HAMILTON, ONT. where it arrived May 24.

The previous latest date for this hammer was 05/05/16.

MA-117a Hmr VI HALIFAX & ST. JOHN R.P.O. / DAY W, SP 13, 20

on a post card addressed to Kitchener, Ontario. Previously the only reported date of use was 08/15/21, which now becomes the latest date and this example, the earliest date. The hammer was proofed 07/06/20.





MA-129 Hmr IV E, DE 24, 02 on a cover from Truro to ARICHAT, N.S.

This is a new early date for this hammer which was reported from 03/10/03.

MA-129 Hmr VII HALIFAX & SIDNEY R.P.O. W, OC 15, 06 cancelling a New Glasgow, N.S. view addressed to Rhode Island.

The earliest date before this discovery was $\frac{\pi}{N}$



MA-138 Hmr XI HALIFAX & YARMOUTH R.P.O. E, DE 27, 28 on a cover from Kentville, N.S. to Waterloo, Ontario. The previous late date for this hammer was 08/07/28.

MA-154 LUNENBURG & MIDDLETON / R.P.O. S, AP 7, 11 This hammer was proofed on 03/06/11 and was known used from 04/12/11, prior to this example on a greeting card addressed to Riverport, N.S.

MA-210 Hmr I St. JOHN & MONTREAL R.P.O. W, MY 24, 00

on a postal stationery envelope front, addressed to Kingston, Ontario. The previous early date for this hammer was 06/04/00.





MA-210 Hmr XXI St. JOHN & MONTREAL R.P.O. 15, JUL 6, 28 on a postcard to Quebec. Previously the latest 1st period date was 12/14/26. The earliest 2ND period date is 10/06/37.

MA-256~Hmr~V~ TRURO & ST. JOHN R.P.O. E, AU 17, 07 on a post card to Sand River, N.S. The previous early date for this hammer was 10/30/07.



MA-256 Hmr IV TRURO & ST. JOHN R.P.O. E, MY 20, 14 cancelling a Moncton view addressed to Amherst, N.S. Before this discovery, the latest date for the hammer was 10/24/11.

MA-240 Hmr V SYDNEY & TRURO R.P.O. 7, MY 17, 59

cancelling a 5c cover from North Sydney to Sackville. Proofed 03/27/57, this hammer was known used from 08/17/59 before this example came to light.





MA-241 Hmr VII SYDNEY & TRURO / R.P.O. 603, MY 3, 61 on a cover from Sydney to Toronto. 603 is a new train number for this hammer.

MA-241 Hmr XIV 5, MR 2, 61 on a cover from New Glasgow to Halifax is

the first reported example of this hammer which was only known from the proof strike, 11/09/60.



In addition to the previous items, I have also found the following items which do not photo-copy well;

MA-80 Hmr XX HALIFAX & CAMP.- R.P.O. / . 3, JUL 31, 29 on a Halifax view post card addressed to Ameliasburg, Ontario. Previously reported from 09/28/31, this is a new early date. The proof date is unknown.

MA-240 Hmr IV SYDNEY & TRURO R.P.O. - R.P.O. / . 6, JUL 11, 60 on a 5c cover to Halifax replaces the former latest reported date, 11/30/59.

MA-11 Hmr III CAMP. & LEVIS - R.P.O. 17, JUL 9, 68

on a block of four, 4 cent centennials

This hammer was previously reported with a 04/29/62 latest date of use. The train number, already known for the listing, is new for the hammer.

on a Montague view addressed to Springfield, Mass. Previously known until 05/06/18, this is a new late date for the hammer.






POSTAGE

MA-69 Hmr I 88, OC 26, 49 on a postcard addressed to Ottawa. Previously this hammer had a late date of 11/24/47. Badly worn, this is a new late date for the hammer.

MA-71 Hmr V E, NO 21, 01 as a transit backstamp registered cover from Ste Anne de la Pocatiere to Halifax. This is a new early date for this hammer which known from was 02/27/02 before now.

Also present are Q-186 E, NO 20, 01 and Q-197 (No 5) E, NO 20, 01.

Registered railway cancellations are all scarce, many are very rare or even unique. Shown here is the only recorded example of RG-5.



This cover originated in BLOOMFIELD, ONT., OC 9, 86 and is addressed to Toronto, where it arrived the following day, as confirmed by the oval, REGISTERED / TORONTO, CANADA arrival backstamp.


The Prince Edward County Railway was opened between Picton, the southern most terminus, and Trenton Junction, a distance of 32 miles, in 1879. In 1882, the railway was re-named, the Central Ontario Railway. By 1884, the line had been extended a further 72 miles north, to Coe Hill.

At Bloomfield, the first stop north of Picton, the cover was placed aboard the north-bound train and was backstamped with RG-5, REGISTERED / C.O.RY. and RR-31, CENTRAL ONT. RWY. NORTH, OC 9, 86. At Trenton Junction, it was transfered aboard the Grand Trunk Railway's west-bound, Kingston to Toronto train and was cancelled with RR-59, G.T.RY. T.& K. / R.P.O. No. 2 WEST, OC 9, 86.



O-71 FT. FRANCES & W'PEG R.P.O./No. 3 22, JAN 29, 16 A new train number in addition to 1, 2, 12, 19, 20, 21, 33 and 34 already reported for the listing.

This hammer is the first of two with "No. 3" at the base and was proofed 11/09/07; the second was proofed 04/15/26. There are also two hammers with "No. 1" at their base, proofed 11/09/07 and 02/26/19, as well as one hammer, proofed 11/09/07, with "No. 2" at its base.

O-420 TRENTON & MAYNOOTH R.P.O. / No.1 63, MY 22, 17 on a cover to Bancroft, Ontario. A new train number for this listing.

O-421 TRENT. & MAY.-R.P.O. / No.2 63, JUL 10, 20 on partial cover to Toronto. A new train number for the listing.

E-30 HALIFAX DISTRICT / EMERGENCY No.1 blank, JUL 17, 41 on a Truro station view post card addressed to Newton, Mass. A new early date. (available for trade!)
