# A Montreal & Island Pond Mystery

There is a **23 year gap** between **QC-169** and **QC-170**, during which there is no postmark listed for what was a very important busy main line route. It is highly probable that mail was carried on the line during that time but no cancellation has been reported. Can anyone suggest an answer?

### Two Western Updates from Rick Parama



I happen to collect Admiral Rate covers and one recent acquisition was the money packet cover illustrated on page 96 of Steinhart's, "The Admiral Era: A Rate Study". It is a cover I had dreamed of owning and it came about rather suprisingly. I had always recognized the scarcer RPO on the front, **WT-677.05**, RIV. & WAIN. R.P.O. /  $\mathbb{N}^{Q}$  5, W, AU 15, 14, but did not realize until I was writing it up, that the indicia, **W**, had not been reported. It so happens there is another unreported indicia on the same cover, a **train 3** for **WT-962.02**, G.T.P. WINNIPEG & RIVERS R.P.O. /  $\mathbb{N}^{Q}$  2, 3, AU 15, 14.

The cover itself is scarce in many ways. It is an early example of an Admiral Money Packet, which prior to April 1st 1922 were required to be sent by the forward letter rate and there was mandatory registration. Thus this is a packet weighing up to 43 ounces or 86 cents postage + 5 cents registration for a total of 91 cents. The 50 cent Admiral is not easy to find on cover, let alone on letter mail. Also the 50 cent Admiral must be from Plate 1 and is the only Plate 1 cover I have recorded. The cover itself is a paste-up. It was applied to a parcel by means of the bank's wax seals at each corner. This explains why the RPO's are on the front of the cover. Money Packets usually carried currency and were mostly used by banks. Allan Steinhart was at one time an RPO collector so it is not too surprising this showed up in his book.



QC-462, QUEBEC & THREE RIV. C.P.R. / \_ M.C. \_ , W, NO 8, 94 , in violet, as a transit backstamp on a registered cover from Quebec to Berthier en Haut, is a new early date for this hammer, which was proof struck on November 2, 1894. Reported by Ross Gray.

Ross also found this new **early date** and first report of a **NORTH** direction for the hammer, **WT-687.02**, S<sup>I</sup> VINCENT & WINNIPEG / M.C., NORTH, DE 24, 82. It appears as a transit backstamp on a 3¢ Small Queen cover from Montreal to Winnipeg.
