## A Faked Fort William & Winnipeg Hammer - Ross Gray



This cover first appeared to be a previously unknown new hammer but careful inspection revealed that the "1" at the base had been skillfully made to look like a "7" and that the year date had been made to look like "28". The cancellation is actually **ON-109.01**, FT. WM. & WPG . R.P.O.  $/ \cdot N^Q 1 \cdot , 3$ , DE 16, 33? . There are no other postmarks. This deceptive cover joins several other similarly modified Western covers which have shown up over the years.

## A New Very Late Date for RY-142 - Ross Gray



Used as a transit postmark on the back of this registered cover from Alberton to Charlottetown, is a surpisingly new **late date** for **RY-142**, P. E. ISLAND  $\cdot$  RY / \_ M.C. \_ , blank, NO 29, 92. Previously the latest reported date was October 13, 1885. It is likely that this very late use is exceptional and therefore the new date will be catalogued as the only **2nd Period date**.

## An Important CPR West of Winnipeg Discovery from Brian Copeland



**Brian Copeland** has discovered a new **late date** for **RY-30.3**, C. P. RY WEST · OF · WINNIPEG / D., WEST, JA 18, 95. It is a transit backstamp on a registered cover from St. John's Newfoundland sent on Jan. 10, 1895 to Victoria BC, where it was received on Jan. 20.

There are also transit marks from Halifax dated Jan. 12 and Jan 14, a QC-251, MONT &  $S^{I} \cdot JOHN \cdot N$ . B / C. P.  $R^{Y}$ , W, JA??, 95, cancel with date obscured and another CPR West of Winnipeg strike, possibly RY-29, C. P.  $R^{Y} \cdot WEST \cdot OF \cdot WINNIPEG$  /  $N^{Q}$  3, W, JA 17, 95.

This discovery considerably narrows the gap between the original and the altered states of the hammer, before and after the "D" was removed..



Brian also reports **WT-827.01**, VIC. & WEL. R.P.O. / B.C. , S, SP 8, 02 , which is a new **early date** for the hammer.
