

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## A New Ontario Clerk Handstamp Report from Ross Gray

This cover cancelled with **ON-153**, GRAVENHURST & NORTH  $\cdot$  BAY  $\cdot$  M.C., N, OC 21, 95, which was proof struck on August 23, 1894, appears to have been sent by the R.P.O. clerk himself, based on the previously unreported handstamp on the back. The handstamp is perfectly struck and centered suggesting that it was intended to identify the sender.





This previously unreported clerk handstamp was used as a transit backstamp on a cover from Kingston, Ontario, dated March 6, 1939 and addressed to Knowlton, Quebec, where it arrived the following day.

It is probably a type CC5R and will now be listed as **QC-533.55**, SUTTON & DRUMMONDVILLE R.P.O. / A. A. L. HOLDEN , Tr 252, MAR 7, (1939).



### **RY-81 Hammer Study Updated**

In the March-April, 2006 newsletter (*page 1929*), we published **Brian Stalker's** study of the two very similar hammers of RY-81. Recently I acquired an additional example of this scarce postmark for my collection and was having difficulty verifying the hammer because of the quality and completeness of the strike. I decided to review my other examples, examining them for variations and was able to find two additional chords to augment the study as shown below.

Subsequent to Brian's study I reported an example of what I identified as RY-81.02 dated July 13, 1861 with an 'EAST' indicium, the only report to date of that direction for the hammer. When I re-examined that strike, I discovered that it was actually RY-81.01. Accordingly the catalogue has now been corrected.

N. DOW, R.M.C. , Tr. 134, APR 23, 1910. The time gap between the reported use of WT-646.011 and its replacement, WT-646.012 suggests the possible loss of WT-646.011 necessitating the use of the clerk's stamp.
