## New Revisions in Town Listings:

Dr. Moffatt has submitted a grouping of new revisions of the town listings for Type One, and Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, Quebec, all Type Two. Illustrated at the end of this listing are two covers I purchased just recently from Jim Hennok, one of our dealer members from the Toronto area. These are both complete Tyler covers and very attractive.

In the listings I am proud of my late date for Springhill Mines and early date for Wolfville, both acquisitions from Hank Narbonne, another of our dealer members who has recently moved over to P. E. I. Hank is with our armed forces and has been transferred to P. E. I. just prior to his retirement from the service. I understand that Hank will be going into the stamp dealer's field on a permanent basis upon retirement. Hank will likely relocate again in Nova Scotia.

## Check Lists for 3 Cent Jubilees and 2 Cent Map Stamps:

The major part of this issue is made up of two tremendous checklists, one for 3 Cent Jubilees and the other for Map Stamps. These, of course, are the work of Dr. Moffatt, and will be extremely helpful to all who specialize in the two issues involved as well as to the rest of us who may just run across the odd item in these areas as we gather our small collections. If you have anything of interest to Dr. Moffatt in these areas be sure to contact him directly.

## Sunday Dates, a Field of Interest for Many:

Brian Plain has written me to say that as a result of the mention in the last issue he can now list 52 towns which used Sunday dates. A number of you not only contacted Brian on these but sent me a note as well. Thanks. Brian has promised to get dates and other data together on this area and will be writing a short piece on this for us in the fall, I hope. Brian is also going to do a bit of work on the three hammers of Victoria and is interested in buying or trading with any collector who has a surplus of Victoria material.

## Wingham, Ontario, Second State:

Many of us have been aware from close study of our handbooks and those Rounding Up Squared Circles articles in Topics that Wingham had an error in year date in 1901 when 10 appeared for 01 for a period of time. According to the 3rd. Edition of the Handbook the late date for the second state of the Wingham hammer is MY 20 / 10. Has this been authenticated as 10, not 01? If it hasn't what is the real late date for this hammer? Brian Plain has a cover with My 27 / 10 (for 01) as well as two other covers, one for JU 24/01 and the other for DE 9 / 01, in both cases these are dated correctly.

### More on Memberships:

Postage costs have risen sharply since we first began producing the Annex and I guess this little production may be running just a bit too many pages at times. Some members have gently reminded me that some issues have been arriving with Postage Due. When I checked these on our office scales originally I found I was just within the low rate but either our scales aren't too good or I have been adding another page or so in a few issues or something since some of you are paying postage dues. I will get this mailing checked at our post office to avoid the problem but if postage for each mailing becomes 20 Cents as I suspect it will we are going to have to make a decision either to increase the cost or cut the material. This could be discussed at Edmonton in the fall where I hope we will get together for a small study group during BNAPEX '77.

With few exceptions, the towns listed are those which might have used the Squared Circle hammer during any part of the year following issue date of the 3¢ Jubilee (JU 19/ 97). An asterisk indicates the town is known on 3¢ Jubilee; a double asterisk indicates that while the town is not yet known on 3¢, it is known on some other denomination of Jubilee. A lower case letter preceding the town name refers to notes which follow this listing. Towns enclosed within parentheses are possibilities, although the probability is low for reasons stated in the notes.

## NOTES

(Known periods of use of the hammer at various towns not yet reported on Jubilees are stated; these periods of use, of course, are subject to extension as further reports come in. In many of these cases, it is probable that the hammer was not in use during the Jubilee period).

- a. ALDERGROVE - known on 1¢ Jubilee, OC 8/ (97?)
- b. BEETON - presently known period of use, MY 6/ 98 to FE 15/ 01, but hammer proofed MY 18/ 93.
- c. MONTREAL, POINT ST. CHARLES - known periods of use MY 15/ 93 to JY 14/ 94 and then not again until the period FE 25/ 99 to MR 13/ 99. Hammer probably not in use 1895 to 1898.
- d. RAT PORTAGE - known period of use MY 8/ 93 to MY 21/ 97; late date is just prior to Jubilee issue date; possible on Jubilee.
- e. ST. ANN'S - known on cover carrying three 1¢ Jubilees, grid cancelling stamps; OC 30/ 97.
- f. ST. HILARION - known on 1¢ Jubilee, 14/ AU/ 97 (three-line date).
- g. BADDECK - known periods of use DE 28/ 93 to MY 21/ 94 and not again until period MY 31/ 99 to AP 6/ 05.
- gg. HALIFAX I - known JY 1/ 93; then AU 26/ 93 to DE 19/ 96 and JA 23/ 97 to MR 30/ 97; followed by two brief revivals: SP 27/ 98 and OC 17/ 98 to OC 20/ 98. Known on 1¢ Jub. and on 2¢ Jubilee (2/ OC 19/ 98), during the late revival period.

h. CLIFTON - two known periods of use, JY 8/ 93 to OC 2/ 94 and  
**NOW REPORTED** MY 5/ 96 to AP 11/ 98; during the latter period, several  
**ON 3¢ JUB.** dates in 1897 are known, including SP 28/ 97. There  
**JY 1- /97** seems no reason, except for the scarcity of the town, to  
**COHEN 2/20/76** expect that it will not eventually show up on Jubilee.

i. NEWCASTLE CREEK - first period of known use is AU 17/ 93 to  
OC 19/ 99, including dates in late June (JU 24) and  
July (JY 22), 1897. There seems no reason this town  
should not eventually be found on cover carrying Jubilee  
stamp (all known examples of this town are free strikes  
on cover, with grid cancelling stamp).

j. DANVILLE - known dates of use, DE ?/ 93 to JA 8/ 94, followed by  
long gap to single report of AP 5/ 98; then no longer  
seen until MR 20/ 03. Hammer probably not in use during  
Jubilee period, but isolated use may turn up.

k. LEVIS - known dates of use FE 23/ 94 to JU 6/ 95, then no more  
until OC 10/ 00; probably not in use during Jubilee period.

l. POINTE-A-PIC - known AU 13/ 93 to AU 23/ 93 and then not again  
until cover with illegibly dated POINTE-A-PIC squared  
circle, but backstamped QUEBEC, AU 12/ 98. Hammer most  
probably not in use during Jubilee period.

m. RICHMOND - known dates of use OC 2/ 93 to NO 4/ 94 and not again  
until OC 18/ 99; probably not in use during Jubilee period.

n. ST. POLYCARPE - known dates of use AU 8/ 93 to MY 20/ 97; late date  
is just prior to Jubilee period. A possibility on Jubilee.

o. SUTTON - known dates of use NO 2/ 94 to DE 1/ 96, followed by  
JU 16/ 02 to DE 24/ 02; probably not in use in 1897, 1898.

p. ANGUS - known periods of use OC 17/ 94 to JU 15/ 96 and OC 4/ 98  
to DE 19/ 98; probably not in use during Jubilee period.

pp. BOBCAYGEON, 2nd State - strikes dated AM/ 13 II/ 61 on 3¢ Jubilee  
exist; these are from covers carrying 3¢ Jubilees sent  
by Doug Crawford to the postmaster at BOBCAYGEON for  
cancellation and return through the mails after news of  
the reappearance of the hammer in its cut-down state  
in December, 1960.

AP 20/97 REVISED AUG 4/1975

q. BRAMPTON - known dates of use SP 20/ 93 to ~~MR 9/ 97~~, followed by  
AU 5/ 08; last date of use in the first period is prior  
to Jubilee period by several months; a possibility.

qq. CACHE BAY - known periods of use OC 29/ 94 to AP 28/ 96; JA 8/ 98  
to MY 21/ 00; and AP 7/ 02 to AP 15/ 05. Hammer probably  
not in use in 1897; nevertheless, late use of Jubilees  
in early 1898 could make this town a possibility on Jubilee.

r. CHESLEY - reported dates of use AP 13/ 94 to AP 13/ 96 and isolated  
NO 23/ 98 (which I believe to be in error); hammer most  
likely not in use during Jubilee period.

*Jubilee*

- rr. HAMILTON - known periods of use DE 15/ 94 to OC 9/ 96; MR 11/ 13 to AU 20/ 14; and NO 18/ 15. Known on 5¢ Jubilee during revival period, but this must be regarded as most abnormal; almost certainly not in use during normal Jubilee period.
- s. KINCARDINE - known period of use NO 1/ 94 to JY 18/ 95 and not again until AP 6/ 99. Almost certainly not in use in 1897.
- ss. LONDON - known dates of use FE 2/ 95 to JA 18/ 97; OC 2/ 98 to OC 17/ 98 and three later revival periods. Occasional sporadic use between first two periods: JY 26/ 97 on 1¢ Jubilee, JY 27/ 97 on 2¢ Jubilee, and JA 11/ 98.
