A Numbers System For Squared Circle Cancels:

As you leaf through the listings section of the Fourth Edition you will note, at the top of each listing, the bar area for Qt: R.F.: and NO., with the No., area left blank. Originally the intention was to number all the cancellers in reverse order to their rarity and insert this number in the space provided. When it was realized that the information on each canceller was being updated right up to the final proofreading it was decided to leave this spot blank and get the book through the printers as soon as possible. The idea was to complete the numbering task after the book was finally put to bed and to include the full numbering system in an issue of the ANNEX. The big job of getting everything in numerical order has now been completed and is presented herewith. Please note that the Precursors have not been included in this grouping at present as it is still believed that that area has not been as fully reported as it should be.

Some older members of the group may wonder at the value of this exercise but I have found this listing extremely useful to me in several ways. Firstly, it has helped me at setting reasonable goals and encouraged me to push on until I now have a bit over 300 in canceller count. I found at each stage in my goal setting program I would reach a point where I did not have certain cancellers which were, at that point, considered easy while I also had a few which were really beyond my goal. Secondly, this may give the serious collectors a good base from which to develop trading or bartering practices. Cancels of similar R.F. value may actually have a fairly different count, particularly at the lower end of the scale, and it is nice to have a ready list of comparison. Thirdly, the list is easily photocopied and can be carried about quite readily in visitation to dealers or other collectors; in this regard the list can be used as a checklist during the earlier stages of collecting Squared Circle cancels and each canceller obtained can be checked off quickly.

Some collectors may wish to enter these numbers in their copy of the Fourth Edition. Others may simply wish to keep the list itself handy. Still others, of course, may think the whole thing is just a needless waste of effort and space. To each his own. Some of us collect Sunday dates, or on certain stamps, or whatever.

The Postal Strike, the Fourth Edition and You

This edition of the ANNEX is being prepared while I am on vacation. The book is now at the printers and is expected to be off the presses about August 24th., a week after I get back from holidays. I hope by then that the postal strike is over and I will be able to post this ANNEX to you the week of August 17th. If that happens you will likely get this before you get your book. The book should, all being well, get to you early in the month of September.

Those of you who took advantage of the pre-publication offer have probably saved a few dollars. I was in touch with Jim Lehr just before I went on holidays and it looked at that time as though the price would have to run to at least \$35.00 or \$40.00 a copy. We have wound up with just 499 pages of material for you so that you should find plenty of good solid information and, probably, plenty of things to complain about. Again, to each his own. Constructive criticism, of course, will be welcome as we prepare, almost

One result of the strike and, as well, our heavy work load in getting the book to press, has been that issues of the ANNEX have been delayed somewhat. As a result, and in order to have the issues of new volumes coincide with the calendar year, this Annex year will run to year-end in which time I will try to have six issues sent out to you. The new Annex year will start January, 1982 and from now on will be on a calendar year basis. It is expected that membership in the Squared Circle Study Group, with the new Handbook stirring up interest, will increase markedly and the printing of the Annex is likely to increase as well. At the moment there are very few back issues available so any new subscribers before year end will likely get only copies of Volume Four. I will have to re-issue some issues of Volume Four but I don't really want to go back further than that.

Anyone with a good photocopying machine, can of course, duplicate old issues and this wouldn't bother me a bit.

At present I have just about exactly 100 members and this works out perfectly on our present Xerox. If the quantity of copies increases I will likely return to using a commercial printer and this may increase costs somewhat. We will have to see. Also I will have to start dropping non payers, I have been too careless this way, and right now I know I am carrying about ten or so free loaders. Next year I will issue just a single reminder to subscribe and will drop all who do not pay before the second issue comes out. Naturally, this doesn't include certain recognized non-payers such as some officials of BNAPS and so on.

Erratum in the Fourth Edition of the Handbook to Appear Here.

At the moment I am aware of a number of errors, mostly minor, that have crept in to the Fourth Edition. As I spot these, or they are reported to me or Bill Moffatt, I will record them in the Annex so that readers can make changes in their books as they go along. I am also going to start a complete file of each listing in the book and of each text page on which I am going to record corrections as well as up-dated information. In this way, when the printing of the fourth edition is sold out and there is a demand for a new edition, we will be able to get a fifth edition to the presses with a good deal of speed and at much less cost than this particular edition. The next Annex will contain the first Erratum sheet and the first up-dated information section. Make sure you report all new finds to either Bill Moffatt or myself, or to both of us, then we will make sure the information is recorded and passed on to you through these pages as we go along.

New Research Needed.

It is quite evident to Bill and I that the new Handbook will likely start a great deal of new research and this is very badly needed. The Annex is a good place to have such research published and I will be glad to print whatever becomes available. It is nice to have anything of value; it is particularly nice to have things that are really ready to be printed. A good clear and black type, done on one side of a standard page of typewriter paper, single spaced just as this is, is best. If you do go to the task of typing material for me be sure that you use a good clear ribbon. If the print gets to me very faint I am just lazy enough to try to use it, as is, in the Annex. Almost invariably the result is not good and I would have been better off to have retyped the whole thing all over again. This is frustrating on all counts.

The balance of this Annex is being reserved for ads which I hope to find waiting me when I get back to work. We will almost be into September by the thime you get the Annex and I will be likely going to BNAPS at Ottawa before I issue the next Annex. This page is partially made up of advertisements I found on my return home, precious few, and some fairly recent requests I have had on hand. I dont really know just what type of service these ads perform for anyone. Since this little newsletter goes to only those who are, presumably, keenly interested in Squared Circles and we do publish a listing of members quite often I would like to think that there is a rather free exchange of correspondence going on. What I would like to see would be a listing of all members, with an indication, star or asterisk perhaps, whether they were actually collectors or dealers. A brief rundown of their particular specialist interests in Squared Circles might also be well worthwhile.
