### CONTEMPORARY CANCELLERS TO THE SQUARED CIRCLE HAMMER - THE JUBILEE PERIOD

This issue of the Annex features a bit of research from Study Group member Joe Smith of Rocky Mountain House, Alberta. Joe went through his "hoard of cancels on Jubilee's" to determine what other types of cancellers were in use at the various offices which used the squared circle cancel.

In the process of sorting through the cancels, Joe also noted any timemarks, early and late usages of other hammers and how their use corresponded to the use of the squared circle hammer.

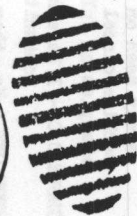
Obviously many Study Group members collect squared circles on the Jubilee issue and probably also collect contemporary cancels as well. As time allows, please drop myself or Joe Smith a note if you can add to or shed any additional thoughts and information to the following pages.

The abbreviations used by Joe in his compilation are as follows:

- CDS - Circular date stamp
- ( ) - Split circle cancel
- SC - Squared circle
- NOH - No other hammer noted (other than a squared circle)
- TM - Timemark

### GORE BAY, ONTARIO STRIKES

I received the strikes below from Bill Moffatt a few years ago along with a hundred or so single strikes of the GORE BAY squared circle hammer. These strikes were made by Mike Squirrel when he visited the Gore Bay post office and found these hammers. Presumably, the dates indicated are the last days of use of the respective hammers.



Background information on other cancelling devices found during the Jubilee era as opposed to squared circle hammers. Era JU 19/97-AP 30/98

MONTREAL- precursors, seldom used to cancel stamps on registered mail so rarely seen on stamp. A wide variety of other hammers and a machine cancel was used to process most mail matter. I have two examples on Jub. stamp, one on 3 cent other on 10 cent (1899).

ALDERGROVE B.C.- I have no copies on any stamps, probably a very tiny community, still a good chance one will show up on Jub.

BEAVERTON ONT.- No other hammer known to be in use. (NOH)

BESTON ONT.- A late bloomer as far as using its SC hammer. Have 11 CDS on Jub., a well worn hammer. Latest date SP 16/97. Also have 3 split rings ( ) dated JY 27/97, AU 14/97, & SP 17/97

BROCKVILLE ONT- BROCKVILLE ONT CANADA duplex all AM.  
" " CDS blank AU 10 & AU 13/97 *Need*  
BROCKVILLE ONT CDS 2 diff. hammers blank/AM

BYNG INLET NORTH ONT- name changed to BYNG INLET, type of hammer used unknown *when?*

COLEMAN ONT- type of hammer used unknown

CUMBERLAND ONT- NOH

DUTTON ONT- NOH

GRIMSBY ONT- 1 example of CDS FM/OC 4/97 *Need*

LONDON ONT- predominate: use of a three ring orb hammer ( 3L1) plus a few strikes using a CDS hammer most often w/ TM PM.

LONDON EAST ONT- NOH

MANSONVILLE QUE- NOH

MOUNT FOREST ONT- NOH

NEW GERMANY ONT- NOH a very small community

OTTAWA CANADA- SC very very common, other cancelling devices include machine, parcel rollers and CDS ( scarce) *duplex*

POINT ST CHARLES QUE- no strikes on Jubs, unknown what type of hammer was in use. *box*

RAT PORTAGE ONT- CDS hammer very common *after 5/24/97*

ST ANNS ONT- rarely seen tying stamps to cover

ST HILARION QUE- ( ) hammer in use with SC hammer which was falling out of favour. *Need*

ST JOHN N.B. CANADA H-III- error in total # reported strikes. I have 12  
positive examples mostly 1 & 2 cent Jubs but  
includes 3x 3 cent. Also 5 other partials.
