Also, it seems logical that a roster project would be a good idea; the last one was in 1980 and some relative scarcities my have shifted. To begin this, please fill out the form attached and return to me at 2364 Gallant Fox Ct., Reston VA 20191-2611 (please note the new zip code). Only compiled data will be published; your individual holdings will remain confidential. Additional pages to keep the project moving ahead will be sent you later. Note that we are trying to accommodate additional specialties beyond 3c Jubilees, 2c Maps, 15c Large Queens, 5c Registration, 10c Special D.

Dues: we will have some; amount and start date to be announced later. I'm told there was some leftover dues money from 1994.

How to fill in the matrix: if you have one off-cover example in a box, write 1. If you have ten off-cover examples, write 10. If you have one cover and none off-cover, write 1c. If you have five off-cover and one cover, write 5+1c. List all shades of 15 cent Large Queen under "30". List all shades of 2c Map under "85". If you have a time mark not listed, write it in one of the blank horizontal spaces. If you run short of space (Ottawa "7" for example), attach a Post-It or use a separate sheet. Take it from there! Keep a copy of the completed sheet for your own use (e.g., insurance records, trading, whatever).
