Type 2 Truro NS - Mike Woods sent a clear strike on piece with 1c Jubilee dated PM/- 11/97 with no month showing; this is probably OC since I have several strikes with only the O of the month. It seems likely that the OC slug was giving trouble throughout the life of the hammer.

Kingston Hmr. II - Jim Felton reports a 14 time mark on OC26/94.

Chairman Joe Smith sent in a most unusual 2c red Victoria numeral with **Lindsay**, 10/OC 9/PM; the time mark is in the bottom and the year (inverted) rides on top.

Don Fraser reports several **Winnipeg** items: Hmr. II blank above on -/JA11/98 (3c Leaf);
Inverted 10 TM on 01/DE 6/94 (3 cent).
Hmr. III incomplete year on 4/JA31/9 (small queen); inverted 4 TM on 4/AP13/97 (3 cent);
month absent on 1/ - 23/97 (1c Jubilee).
