NEW REPORTS

Precursor Montreal - Jim Miller reports a late usage of Hammer 2, AP 5 A 8/02 with worn appearance on a 2c envelope with 5c numeral added from Quebec City 15/AP 4/02 addressed to Montreal.

Type I Mount Forest - Mike Woods reports a record early strike, -/JU 1/93, and an inverted month/day line, -/41 ?/?, both on 3c small q.; the latter a partial strike.

Terrebonne - Mike also reports a record early, -/MY 1/93, on 3c small q.

Type 2 Port Williams - Mike also reports a record early, -/NO 3/93, on a strip of 1c small q.

Prescott - Jim Felton sent a 7/DE13/94 strike on 1c small queen, a previously unreported time mark. In perusing the Moffatt archive, there was a 1/MR 5/95 report; maybe not an error?

St. Thomas - Barry Douglas reports an inverted 3 in the day on PM/MY 3/95.

Toronto - Barry also reports a missing month with the TM center slot arrangement, 1/7PM/94 on a 5c small queen.

Strachan Avenue - Barry also reports a new latest, AM/AP 8/99, on Map.

Waterloo - Barry also reports one more example of 3-letter mo. on PM/JAN22/15, on 2c Admiral.

Windsor - Barry also reports an inverted day on AM/OC25/? (year unclear, could be 95 or 97).

Woodstock - First period of use extended to -/FE25/95, on a 3c in editor's collection. The second period of use is -/AP 5/98 to -/AP30/98; the third period -/AP26/99 to -/OC23/99.

Brandon - Jim Felton sent a bold -/JA -/99 strike on 1c Numeral, no day showing.

Winnipeg I ham. - Tony Shaman reports 4/SP21/97 with a prone 4 (1c Jubilee) and a funny date arrangement 4/24SP/97 on 2c Jubilee. He has 1/4 ON/97 on 2c s.q., same day as below (ham. II).

Winnipeg II ham. - Dave Kelly reports late usage on a 2c lettercard, 6/AU24/98.

Winnipeg II and III ham. - Tony Shaman also reported time marks 17/NO 4/97 (II) and 17/OC15/97 (III), both on 3c Jub.

HANDBOOK UPDATES

For Montreal (barred) Hammer 5, in looking through the Moffatt archive provided by Gary Arnold, the latest report was MY17 12P/04, a new TM and extending the period of use by over a year. There was also a MR11 7A/02 report, a new TM. Most of the 12 known strikes bear 11A.

For Aldergrove, the 4th Edition Handbook mentions an invert 4 date in 96 on 3c s.q. Some years back, Warren Bosch lent this strike to your editor so that it could be photographed. I just now noticed that the correct date is $-/DE \frac{4}{95}$


THE DUES


