NEW REPORTS

**Melbourne** - at ORAPEX earlier this year I bought a 1c Edw. picture postcard dated -/AU21/0 but the receiving mark in Detroit says 06. The only other 06 report in the archive is SP27. Any more like this out there?

**Arnprior** - an early use of the 3-line style on AP/19/06, on 2c E7, just now received from a dealer in British Columbia.

**Ripley** - from the same source, the second 1903 report dated NO17, on 2c E7 (refer to October 98 Annex #87)

**York Street/Toronto** - a borrowed small zero in the day on 12NOON/FE10/00, on 2c red Victoria. Examine your holdings; there must be more of these around.

**Woodville** - the 2nd (1901) period of use encompasses 7 strikes: JA11, 23; FE18; MR18, 20, 22; AP27. Any additional reports will be welcome.

**Lethbridge** - an obvious fake has turned up on a 6c Jubilee, of all things; it bears a 98 date but the digits of the year are abnormally large (Joe Smith lassoed this one).
