NEW REPORTS

Precursor London - Barry Douglas has a previously unrecorded time mark AP20 11A/92 on 3 cent. It turns out MY28 11A/92 on postcard was Lot 1121 in Lee's #49 sale.

Precursor Montreal Hmr. 3 - Jim Hennok's April sale includes an OC25A10/00 backstamp which is late usage for this hammer; note however that it is often difficult to distinguish Hmrs. 3 and 4.

Precursor Montreal Hmr. V - Hennok's sale includes a 6P favor strike on 5c Numeral, and an 8A backstamp on Australian origin cover. There are now 16 reports of this hammer, bringing the RF to 120.

Type 2 Maitland - the NO25/95 strike on 3 cents in Hennok's sale is the first 95 report, however the strike is messy and could be 93.

Charlottetown - the first report of an inverted AM time mark, from Dave Handelman. A picture of this is promised for the next issue of Topics.

Schreiber II - a second example of the missing zero in year, and the first 05 report, on -/DE 2/5 on a 2c Edw. sent by a dealer in British Columbia. ✓

York Street - the second blank-above period is now known to include FE24/96, on a 2 cent.

Gretna - in perusing Bob Lee's auction catalog #50 dated Aug. 88 I find that the late record date is OC16/02 (free strike, illustrated) on a 2c red cover.

Winnipeg III - Gerry Carr found a 41/SP18/97 strike on 3c Jubilee, presumably reversed 14; but there has been no report of TM 14 normally arranged for this hammer.

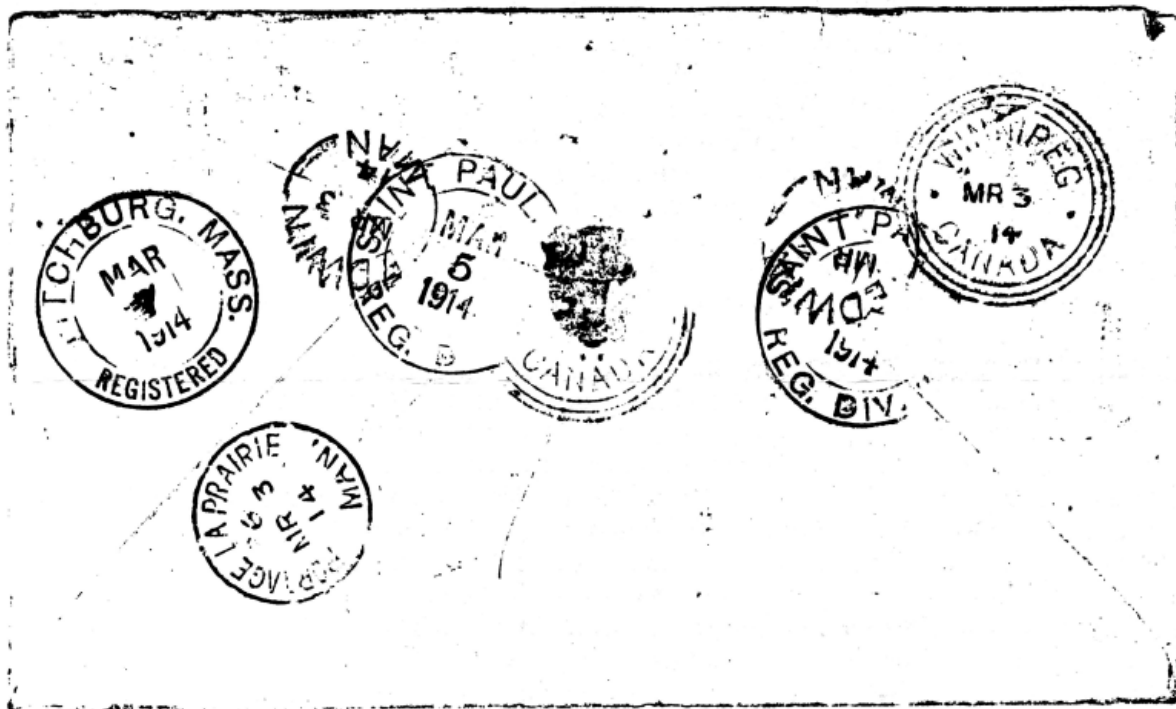
