As usual many worthwhile items were found in the dealers' stocks, there were some nice exhibits to look at too. Our study group meeting on Saturday was well attended

<u>NEW REPORTS</u> (Bill Longley has kindly provided a cdrom of images from the Hennok collection, these are \* below)

**Precursor Montreal I** - early transit use FE261P/92 on 41/F2 cover from Port Coldwell to St. Ferdinand, reported by Peter Laycock; this is the only 1P indicia reported.

Type 2 Sackville - first reported Jubilee cover dated -/AU28/97, provided by Hank Narbonne.

Montreal II - the Hennok collection has a 1 cent, 3/JA16/PM.

Quebec - inverted month on 1/AJ 5/98, reported by Larry Grossman.

Ste.Cunegonde - day before month and inverted month on 6 <u>UJ</u>/94, Larry G. (could be JU 9 inverted).

Alma II - the 2nd report in Period 2 on -/JA 9/01, free strike on 2c numeral cover, from Hank N.

**Aylmer West \* -** the MR27/99 strike is blank above the date.

Belleville I \* - the timemark in the earliest strike is 3. A prone  $\underline{4}$  timemark occurs on JY20/93.

Belleville II \* - odd indicia 13/DE19/4 occurs in 2 examples. The timemark in the latest strike is 2.

Durham - on a 20c orange Weed, most unusual, reported by Bill Radcliffe.

Fonthill \* - a forgery is known dated 1898.

Gravnhurst \* - early use on PM/SP20/93.

**Huntsville** \* - inverted AM on MA/JU 1/?.

Ingersoll \* - blank above date on AP24/96. Late usage on PM/JY23/98.

Kingston III \* - the 9/JUL30/02 strike is confirmed and now 4 strikes exist.

Kingsville \* - the two 1c queens have been reunited and now one strike exists.

Lindsay \* - early use on -/SP27/93.

Little Current \* - inverted 4 in the year on -/JU 1/94.

Martintown \* - early use in violet on -/JY 3/93.

Mattawa \* - inverted month -/CO19/95.

Nassagaweya \* - a favor strike on 5c commems is known -/SP 7/60. Horace used to tell us about a favor strike on Jubilee which was shown at a club meeting & then subsequently destroyed.

Owen Sound \* - prone 4 in the day on B/JY 4/98.

Paisley \* - early use on -/MR15/94.

Palmerston \* - the 2 examples in the Hennok collection are on 1c and 3c.

Paris \* - inverted A on AP11/98; inverted B on AP 9/98; inverted C on AP 7/98.

Pontypool \* - the Hennok collection contains an 8c cover.

Ripley \* - PM/DE07/98 (early for 2nd period of PM).

Seelys Bay \* - the AM/JA13/02 strike is confirmed.

**Shakespeare** \* - early use on -/SP25/94.

Bleeker St. I - inverted digit in day on -/JA27/95 (one cent) in Bob Lee's #113 sale.

Parliament Street \* - odd indicia on 9/JA 2/PM (2c sm.q.).

Waterdown \* - a real surprise, -/AP 2/97 on a postcard.

Wiarton \* - -/JU 7 and 8/49 are known.

**Windsor** \* - the earliest is AM/SP27/93. Late Map use on PM/MR13/99. Inverted PM on JA15/98.

Morden \* - 1934 use on JAN 22.

Winnipeg IV \* - timemark 2 reported in initial period.

Grenfell \* - early use on -/FE 7/95. On 50c Weed, most unuaual, seen on eBay.

**Prince Albert** \* - isolated use on -/JA27/98 (1c2c leaf cover). Early Period 8 use on AM/FE21/55.

Innisfail \* - late use on -/MY14/03.


