NEW REPORTS (late getting this one out, sorry)

**Type II Baddeck** – 1895 usage on -/MR 9 (one cent), Dave Robinson.

**Truro** – Chairman Joe reported an auction listing for a Nova Scotia #10 5c blue dated OC3/98, must be a favor cancel.

**Hull II** - a 15c Large was sold on eBay recently and I got a report of one other,

**Magog** – missing digit on -/SP 0/97, 1c Jubilee, Bill Radcliffe.

**Bowmanville** – Wayne Walton has an illustrated 3c cover dated FE12/94.

**Flesherton** – the first Special Delivery report, cover dated -/OC17/99, offered from Argentina.

**Gore Bay** – another 3-letter month on -/JUL23/08 on 2c Quebec, Chairman Joe.

**London** – surprising item, \$1 with year off stamp, possibly 99, seen on eBay.

**Oxford Mills** – 3-line date on AP/5/99, 2c purple numeral, Paul Chiles.

**Pembroke** – no year on -/ JY 4/-, offered by 'viti' (small queen).

**Toronto** – unusual indicia on PM4/JY 3/CO with the OC inverted for the year, Dave R.

**Strachan Avenue** – surprise, a 2c RLS AM/MR22, probably 95 reported by Bill Longley (May 27 sale, lot 455).

**Wellington** – early use on -/DE11/94 on an 8 cent, found at North Bay by Bill Radcliffe.

**Whitby** – in Period I a postcard dated AU 2 (late use) was reported some time ago, I neglected to tell you this before.

**Wingham** – digit missing on -/AU10/9- , other marking on card shows 97, Bruce K.

**Minnedosa** – 1903 usage on -/MY13, on one cent, Dave R.

**Winnipeg I** - Dave also reports inverted month CO in 1896: 20<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>. In 96 hmr 3 was dominant, hmr 1 was occasional.

Wpg II – blank above date on DE31/97 (small queen), received from Jim Waddell.

Nanaimo – late use on 14/JU(N?) 5/56 on 4c 1949 Nfld (month could be July, impression is poor), offered by Paul Chiles. Note the 1955 report is a 4c War Issue cover

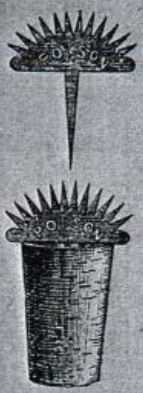
