

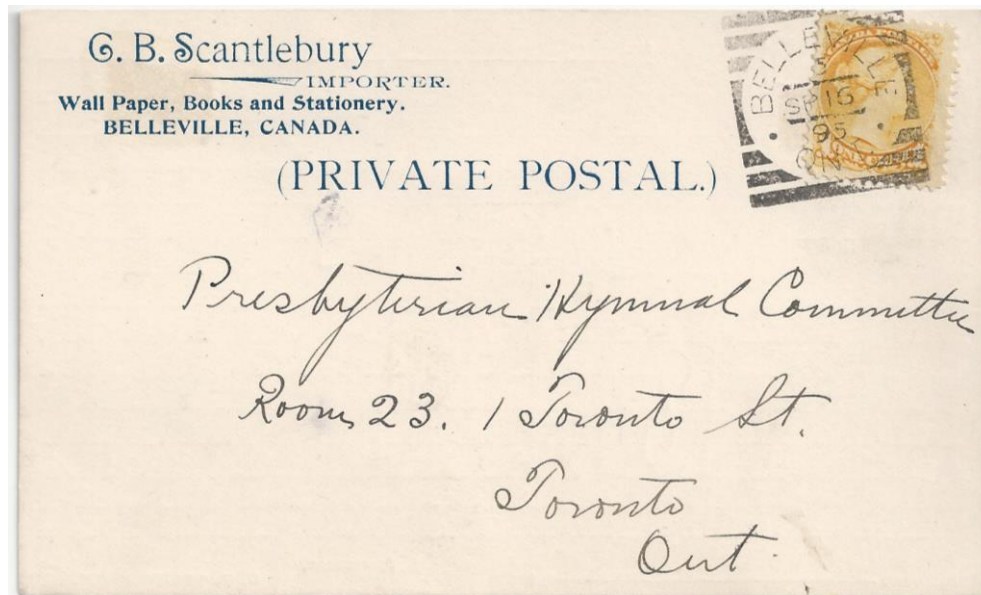
NEW REPORTS AND UPDATES

Farnham, QUE: The first reported strike on a Map stamp (below); the strike is dated -/JA 28/99.



Angus, ONT: First report of this hammer on an 8 Cent Numeral Queen; strike is the latest reported date of use, -/DE 19/98.

Belleville, ONT Hmr II: First report of a “5” time mark; strike on cover with 1 Cent Small Queen (below) is dated 5/SP 16/95



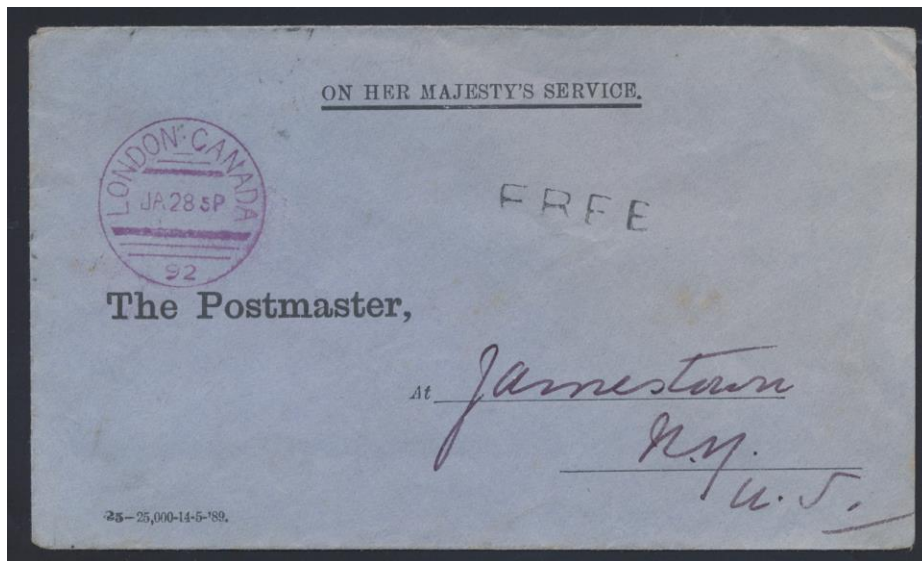
Guelph, ONT: A second report of an inverted “PM” time mark on a 3 Cent Small Queen stamp; strike is dated PM/MR 27/95.

Hamilton, ONT: Three (3) examples on one-half Cent Small Queens; unreported in Handbook – strikes dated 14/MR 25/96 (top, right), 14/SP 13/95 and 11/OC 9/96.

NEW REPORTS AND UPDATES (Continued)

International Bridge, ONT: A new earliest reported date; the strike is on a 3 Cent Small Queen, dated -/JY 7/93.

London, Ont. Precursor: First reported strike of this hammer using colored ink.



Peterborough, ONT: Unreported time mark indicia error; strike dated 44/ OC 3/94 on a 3 Cent SQ.

Waterloo, ONT: A new year of use during the Admiral Period; strike is dated -/MY 10/21. This strike is the second example in the Admiral Period of a blank time mark slot; AM or PM are typically used.

Waterloo, ONT: First example of a free strike dater dispatching cancel during the Admiral Period (below); strikes dated AM/AP 16/12. All other dispatching cancels are combination dater/obliterators.



NEW REPORTS AND UPDATES (Continued)

Victoria, B.C. HMR I: A strike on a 3 Cent Small Queen, dated NT/AP 27/94 with the 4 inverted. Handbook notes this occurrence on NT/AP 28/94 and a correct indicia placement on AP 26.

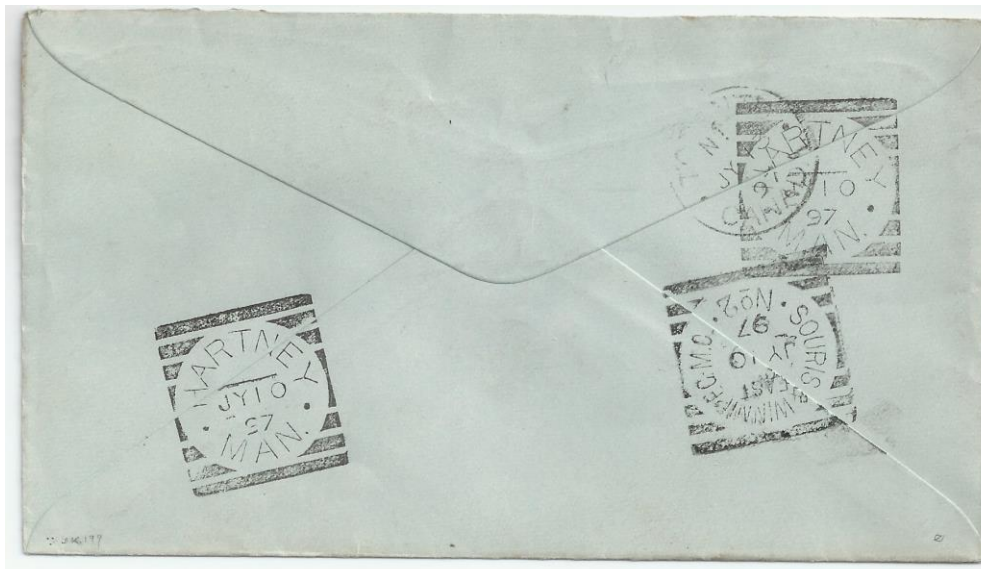
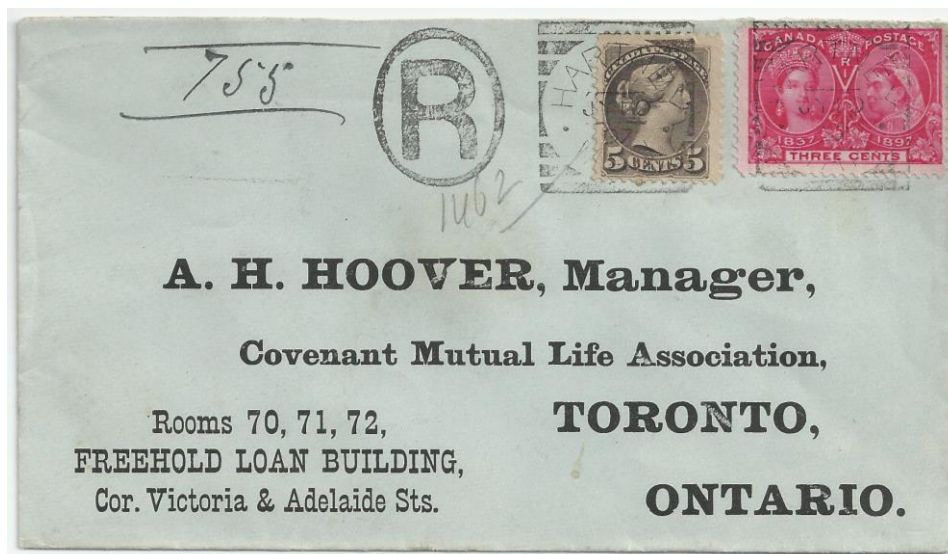
Victoria, B.C. HMR I: Previously unreported indicia placement on a strike dated NT/7 AP/94.

Hamilton, ONT Precursor: First reported strike on 2 Cent Small Queen; strike dated XXXXXXXX.

Hamilton, ONT Precursor: Indicia error, upside down "1" on strike dated MR 19 6P/XX on 3 Cent Small Queen stamp.
