Pictou, NS: First reported strike on a 2 Cent Numeral; strike on stamp is dated -/NO 3/99.



Dundas, ONT: First reported strike on a 2 Cent Numeral; strike on stamp is dated PM/MR 1/00.

Georgetown, ONT: New latest reported date, -/MY 11/03, strike on 1 Cent Leaf GPC. (above left).

Hamilton, ONT: First reported strike on 10 Cent Jubilee; out of period strike is dated 16/AU 23/13.

Mill-Brook, ONT: New earliest reported date; strike on 3 Cent Small Queen stamp dated -/JU 10/95 (above, center).

Niagara Falls South, ONT: First reported strike on an 8 Cent Numeral stamp; strike is dated -/NO 22/98.

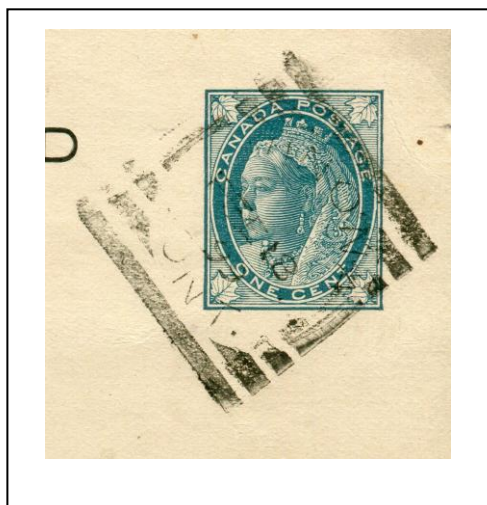
North Bay, ONT: First reported use of a zero spacer in date; strike on 8 Cent Small Queen stamp is dated -/NO 08/94.

Petrolea, ONT: New earliest reported date on a 3 Cent Small Queen stamp; strike is dated -/FE 14/94.

Prescott, ONT: First reported strike on an 8 Cent Numeral stamp; strike is dated -/AP 3/99.

Seelys Bay, ONT: First reported strike on a 5 Cent Registered Letter stamp; partial strike is dated -/AU 26/?

Winona, ONT: Unreported indicia error on 1 Cent GPC; strike is dated -/FEE 18/99 (at left).

Hartney, MAN: First reported strike on a 2 Cent Numeral; strike on stamp is dated -/MR 1/00.

Winnipeg, MAN, Hmr IV: First reported strike on a 5 Cent Registered Letter stamp; the strike is dated -/SP 1/93.

Victoria, BC Hmr III: First reported strike on a 6 Cent Numeral stamp; partial strike on stamp is dated NT/NO 29/?

Halifax, NS Hammer I: Indicia error "64" for year date on 1894 1 Cent Small Queen dated 2/OC 18/64.

Stellarton, NS: Use of a small "o" in year date on a 2 Cent Numeral stamp; strike dated -/JU 19/0o.

Ste. Cunegonde, QUE: Inverted TM indicia on a strike dated PM/MY 17/9?.

Victoriaville, QUE: Year error on 3 Cent Small Queen; strike dated -/SP 5/5.

Victoriaville, QUE. Reversed March indicia; strike on 3 Cent Small Queen dated -/RM 15/95.

Dunnville, ONT: Indicia error, no month indicia; strike on 2 Cent Edward dated -/ 29/ 09

Huntsville, ONT: Reversed order day indicia; strike on 3 Cent Leaf issue dated PM/2 JU/98.

Lakefield, ONT: Year date indicia error, missing year; strike on 2 Cent Numeral dated 1/FE 27/0.

Leamington, ONT: First report of a nude strike, on a 3 Cent Small Queen.

Peterborough, ONT: Reversed month indicia; strike on 1 Cent Small Queen dated 1/U- 3/97

Peterborough, ONT: Month indicia error; no month indicia on 3 Cent Jubilee strike dated 2/- 21/97.

Port Hope, ONT: Borrowed year date indicia "9"; strike on Map stamp dated -/DE 19/99.

Rodney, ONT: Year date indicia error "87" for "97"; strike on 3 Cent Small Queen dated -/OC 30/87

Hartney, MAN: Broken indicia "E" in February dated strike on 3 Cent Small Queen; -/FF 24/96.

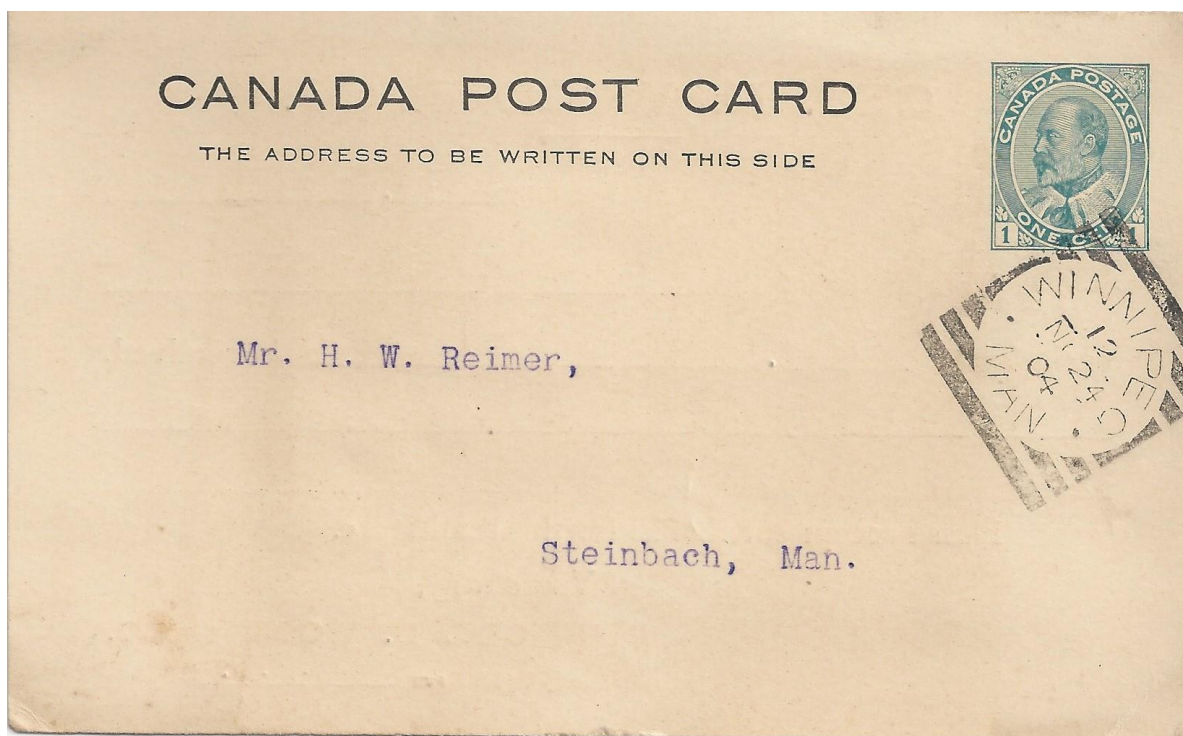
Hartney, MAN: Reversed month indicia and date arrangement; strike on 3 Cent Small Queen dated -/?? CO/9?

Neepawa, MAN: Year date indicia error "67" for "97"; strike on 3 Cent Small Queen -/NO 29/67

Victoria, BC Hammer III: Reversed day date arrangement; strike on 3 Cent Leaf dated NT/2 MY/98.

A discussion ensued about the need for an updated handbook and/or electronic database of squared circles. It was noted that the 2000 handbook compiled and edited by former chairman, Jack Gordon, is now very out of date with many new finds and information “out there” without adequate record.

The discussion also included the need for a vice-chairman for the study group and someone to work on the book/database. Member Rick Friesen has volunteered to take on the role of VP and head up the database task. It was moved by Paul Sneyd and seconded by Paul Grimm that Rick Friesen be appointed Vice Chairman. There were no further nominations and the vote was unanimous.

It was subsequently moved by Laurent Belisle and Seconded by Bill Radcliffe that we undertake the development of a new handbook/database under the leadership of Rick Friesen. Also approved unanimously.
