

QUEBEC NEW REPORTS/ HANDBOOK UPDATES – PART THREE

The following is the third and final installment of Laurent Belisle's updates and new reports of Quebec squared circle strikes in his collection.

Sherbrooke, Hmr I: First reported strike on 1c Gov't Envelope, strike dated 1/OC18/98
First reported strike on 2c Gov't Envelope; strike dated 1/MR 7/99

Terrebonne: First reported strike on 1c Gov't postcard; dated -/OC22/95
First reported strike on 5c QV Leaf; -/AP 14/99 on registered cover (below)



Three Rivers: First reported strike on 1c Gov't Env; dated -/OC11/94
First reported strike on 2c Letter Card; dated -/NO6/95
First reported strike on 3c Letter Card; dated -/SP3/97

QUE. & CAMP. M.C. Local: Most of the following information is on the number of covers, note in the January SPARKS auction a lot of 10 covers lot 1334 (1 No.5 and 9 No.20) was offered.

QUE. & CAMP. M.C. LOCAL No.5:

I have 2 REGISTRATION RECEIPTS dated E/SP25/95, W/SP26/95 and 6 covers dated: W/NO 27/94, W/AP 17/95, W/JY 12/99 (the W/JY 12/99 cover is addressed to Trois-Rivières P.Q. with 3c Jubilee, 2cp Num, 3c env for 8c), W/JUL 4/08, E/FE 11/09, 15/SP 13/11: these 6 covers are different from those listed in the 6th Handbook plus 8 covers in 6th edition plus a cover described in Vic Willson's article (2003 Topics Issue 3) for a total of 15.

QUE. & CAMP. M.C. LOCAL No.5 (Continued)

First reported strike on 1c Gov't postcard; strike dated W/NO 27/94.
First reported strike on 8c Small Queen; cover with backstamp dated
W/AP 17/95
First reported strike 1c Edward, on postcard dated 150/SP 13/11

QUE. & CAMP. M.C. LOCAL No.20 State 1:

I have 4 covers including the E/AP 12/95 and -/JU 27/95 is a fifth example (3 reported in the 6th Edition Handbook).

QUE. & CAMP. M.C. LOCAL No.20 State 2

I have 6 covers + LRD + postcard W/JY 16/97; total of 8 covers (5 covers reported in the 6th Edition Handbook).

QUE. & CAMP. M.C. LOCAL No.20 State 3

2 postcards + 3 covers listed in 6th edition + 1 new report; 6 covers total now reported (4 reported in the 6th Edition Handbook).
First reported strike on 2c QV Leaf; on cover, strike dated W/????/99 (below/top)

QUE. & CAMP. M.C. LOCAL No.20 State 6

I have 16 covers + 12 listed in Kerzner/Sparks sale STK-1: minimum 28 covers reported. (12 covers reported in the 6th Edition Handbook)
First reported strikes on 7c Edward, a strike dated E/AU 17/05 and a backstamp on cover, dated E/MY 24/04 (below, bottom)



NEW REPORTS AND UPDATE

London, ONT, State 2: David Robinson sent scans of four London strikes: three exhibit inverted month/day indicia line, PM/4 PA/96, which is noted in the 6th Edition Handbook. The fourth strike (below right) has the correct month/day indicia arrangement: PM/AP 4/96.



Rat Portage. ONT: The first reported strikes on One Cent and Three Cent Letter Cards; strikes are dated -/MY 9/95 or 96 (below, left) and -/JY 3/96 (below, right).



Shannonville, ONT: New *Earliest Reported Date*; on 1 Cent Small Queen stamp dated -/JU 23/93 (right).

Milltown. NB: First reported strike on a 1 Cent Jubilee issue; strike on a registered cover is dated PM/FE 28/02



Summerside, PEI: First reported strike on a 5 Cent Small Queen; strike on pair of stamps dated -/OC 24/97.

Alymer East, Que: New *Latest Reported Date*; dated -/OC 20/03 (right, bottom)

Granby, QUE: First reported strike on a 2 Cent QV Leaf; dated -/OC 17/98.

Notre Dame St. West Montreal: First reported strike on a ½ Cent Small Queen; (left) dated 19/JA 9/96.



NEW REPORTS AND UPDATES (Continued)



Dunnville, ONT: Strike on 8 Cent QV Numeral issue dated -/DE 19/98; not previously reported on this stamp (left).

Humberstone, ONT: First reported strike on 3 Cent Gov't envelope; strike dated -/SP 17/98.

Mitchell, ONT: First reported strike on 1 Cent Gov't envelope; strike dated -/MY 23/98

Picton, ONT: First reported strike on 15 Cent Large Queen; on pair of stamps, dated 2/DE 27/97.

Sudbury, ONT: Strike on 8 Cent Leaf stamp, dated -/MY 30/98; unreported on this stamp.

Waterdown, ONT: A second reported strike on cover, light strike dated -/JY 4/94 on 1 Cent Government Postcard (below)



Medicine Hat, ASSA: First reported strike on 5 Cent Small Queen; dated -/MR 7/95 (or 96).

Nanaimo, B.C. State Two: Two reports on Nanaimo State Two from Brian Copeland.



The first reported "20" time mark for this hammer (right) on a 13 Cent Pictorial Issue; strike dated 20/JUL 7/39



The first report of a day preceding the month indicia on a piece (left); strike dated 7/19 MY/54.

Nanaimo, B.C. State Two: An additional report of a late date, strike on 2 Cent QE Wilding stamp on piece; strike is dated 14/JU(N or L) 3/56.
