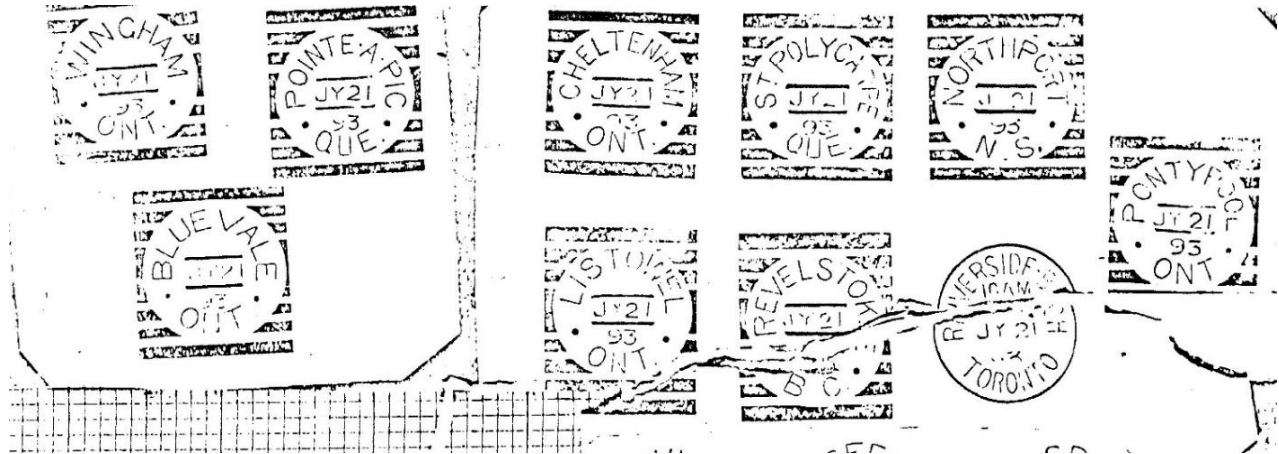


AN INTERESTING DAY AT PRITCHARD & ANDREWS



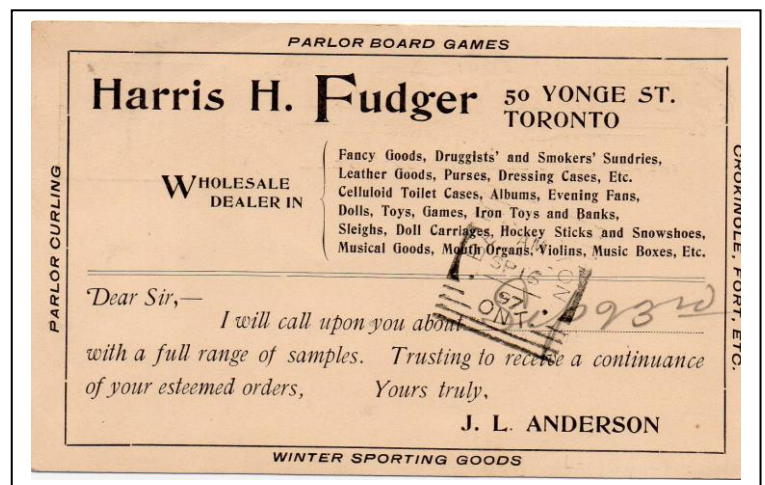
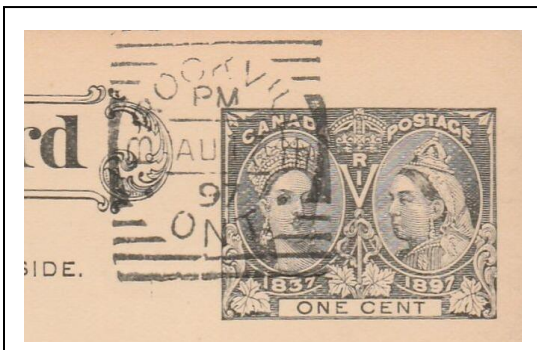
I was going through a photocopy of the Pritchard & Andrews proof book pages Frank Campbell gave me years ago, and came across this page of proof strikes, dated July 21, 1893.

Note the hammers that ultimately turned out to be among the most scarce/rare squared circle strikes; **WINGHAM, ONT STATE I RF 130**; **POINTE-A-PIC, QUE. RF 140**; **ST. POLYCARPE, QUE RF 55**; **PONTYPOOL, ONT RF 100**, **BLUE VALE, ONT RF 80** and **REVELSTOKE, BC RF 220**. I don't believe another day's production can match or beat July 21, 1893.

Brockville, ONT: First reported strike on a Jubilee postcard; strike dated PM/AU 17/97 (below)



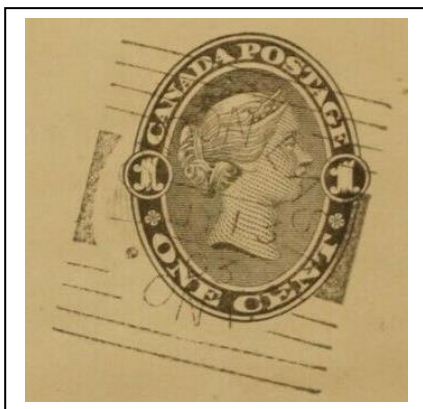
NEW REPORTS AND UPDATES (Continued)

Brockville, ONT: First reported strike on a 10 Cent QV Numeral issue. strike on stamp dated PM/MR 22/00.

Cumberland, ONT: First reported strike on a Jubilee postcard; strike dated -/OC 25/97 (below, left)

London East, ONT: **New latest reported date** by almost two years, on a 1 Cent Government postcard; strike is dated -/JY 13/03 (below, middle)

London East, ONT: First reported strike on a Jubilee postcard; free strike dated -/JY ?/97 (below, right)



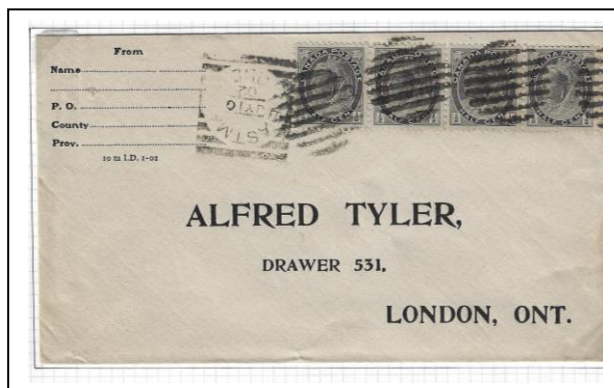
St. Ann's, ONT: First reported strike on a Jubilee postcard; free strike dated -/JU 24/97.

Canso, NS: First reported strike on a 1/2 Cent QV Leaf issue; strike on cover with 2 Cent Jubilee issue dated -/SP 10/94 (below, left)

Halifax, NS, Hammer I: First reported strike on a ½ Cent Large Queen; partial date -/OC -/.

St. John, NB Hmr II: First reported strike on a Jubilee postcard; dated AM/AP 2/97.

Eastman, QUE: First reported strike on the ½ Cent Numeral issue, dated -/JY 10/02 (below, right)



Bracebridge, ONT: First reported strike on a 3 Cent Government envelope; strike dated -/SP 10/94

NEW REPORTS AND UPDATES (Continued)

Georgetown, ONT: First reported strike on a 1 Cent Letter Card, uprated with 1 Cent and 2 Cent QV Numerals to pay the 5 Cent rate to Paris, France (below, left); strike dated -/AU 2/98

Huntsville, ONT: First reported strike on a 1/2 Cent QV Leaf issue; strike on cover with 1 Cent QV bisect issue dated PM/MY 20/99 (below, right)



Leamington, ONT: First reported strike on an 8 Cent QV Numeral issue; the strike is dated -/NO 10/98 (below, left)



Mattawa, ONT: The first reported strike on a 2 Cent Small Queen issue; backstamp transit postmark on a cover franked with 2 Cent Small Queen, 1 Cent QV Numeral and two 2 Cent QV Numeral issues.; strike is dated -/MR 25/99

Merrickville, ONT: An additional example of a zero spacer in the day date indicia; strike on a Map stamp dated AM/JA 09/99 (above, middle)

Mount Brydges, ONT: The first reported strike on a 3 Cent Letter Card; backstamp, dated -/AP 8/97

Newmarket, ONT: First reported strike on a 2 Cent Small Queen issue; on business corner advertising cover with 1 Cent Small Queen issue; strike dated -/NO 19/94.

Picton, ONT: First reported strike on the 1/2 Cent QV Leaf issue; strike is dated PM/MR 3/00 (above, right)

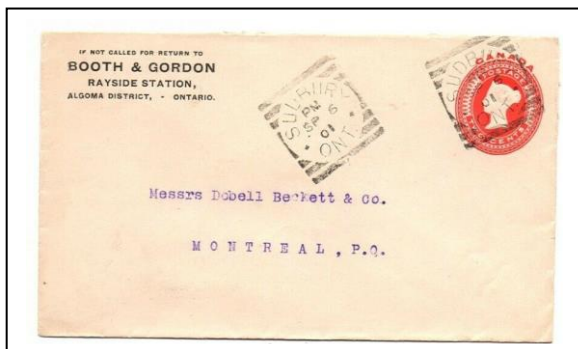
NEW REPORTS AND UPDATES (Continued)

Port Arthur, ONT: First reported strikes on the 5 Cent and 10 Cent Edward issues; strikes are dated -/JA 21/09 and -/FE 15/11? (faint, partial date). (below left and center)



Smiths Falls, ONT: First reported strike on the 10 Cent Small Queen issue; partial strike on stamp.

Sudbury, ONT: First reported strike on a 2 Cent Government Envelope; strike dated PM/SP 6/01 (below, left)



Tavistock, ONT: First reported strike on a Jubilee postcard; backstamp strike dated -/JY 28/97

Bleecker Street TORONTO Hmr II: First reported strike on a 1 Cent Government Envelope; strike dated -/SP 23/95 (above, right)

York Street TORONTO: First reported strike on a Jubilee postcard; dated 6:30/FE 4/98 (below, left)

Hartney, MAN: First reported strike on 2 Cent Jubilee; strike on cover dated -/AP 22/99 (below, right)
