Halifax, NS, Hmr 1: A third reported example for Period 5; strike on 1 cent QV Numeral dated 4/SP 9/98.

Halifax, NS Hmr 1: New Latest Reported Date for Period 6; strike on 3 cent Small Queen dated 4/NO 18/98

Kentville, ONT: Partial day date indicia; strike on 1 cent Small Queen dated -/JA 0/94 (Below, left)

Lunenburg, NS: First reported strike on 2 cent Small Queen issue; strike on stamp dated -/?E 18/?

Lunenburg, NS: Additional dates for PM time marks: JY 7, JY 23, AU 11, ?P 1 (likely SP)

Newport Landing, NS: Additional 1905 dated strikes; -/NO 22 and -/NO 29, both receivers on US postcards Newport Landing, NS: New Earliest Reported Date for Period 6; strike on 2 cent Edward dated -/MY 28/07 Newport Landing, NS: First reported strike on 2 cent Quebec Tercentenary issue; dated -/SP 21/08







Northport, NS: New Latest Reported Date for Period 1; strike on 2 cent QV Numeral (red) dated -/MY 5/03; also, second reported 1903 year date.

Northport, NS: First reported strike on 2 cent Edward and first 1904 strike, -/OC 20/04 on cut down cover.

Port Williams, NS: First reported strike on a 1 cent Gov't post card; strike dated -/JA 20/99 (Above, left)

Port Williams, NS: First reported strike on a 2 cent Small Queen; strike dated -/MR 21/95 (Above, center)

Truro, NS: First reported strike on a 10 cent QV Leaf issue; strike dated PM/OC 19/98.

Windsor, NS: New Earliest Reported Date for AM/PM time mark; strike dated PM/AP 13/96.(Above, right)

Yarmouth, NS State 1: David provided his inventory of this hammer: 69 off cover (AM, PM, Blank time marks); 8 on cover (AM, PM, Blank). Current Handbook inventory lists 55 off cover and 16 on cover. Using David's 69 off-cover and the Handbook's 16 on covers, the RF changes from 60 to 55.

Humberstone, ONT: First reported strike on a 5 cent Small Queen issue; strike on stamp dated -/OC 1?/9?.

Iroquois, ONT: Additional report of a small zero in year date; backstamp on Map cover dated -/JA 30/00

Listowel, ONT: First reported 1896 strike, light strike on a 3 cent Small Queen issue, dated -/OC 19/96.

Niagara, ONT: Rick Friesen provided a clarification on the **Latest Reported Date** for the hammer; the LRD.is actually **-/FE 28/02**. The previous LRD was misread as -/FE 23/02, determined from 2 lots containing light strikes on facing slips in the 2017 Sparks/Kerzner sale (Lots 3416 and 3593).

North Bay, ONT: First reported strike on 20 cent Widow Weed; light strike on stamp dated -/DE 2/93.

Orillia, ONT: First reported strike on a 2c/3c QV Leaf issue; strike on cover date not discernible (Above, right)

Port Hope, ONT: First reported strike on a 15 cent Jubilee issue; strike dated -/JY 27/98 (Right)

Toronto, York Street: Second report of a 5:30 (PM) time mark; strike on 1 cent SQ dated 5:30 ?/DE ?/96.

Waterloo, ONT: First reported strike on a 2 cent Gov't post card; strike dated --/DE 19/94

Wiarton, ONT: David Robinson sent the following updates for this relatively scarce hammer (RF 60)

- First reported strike on a 5 cent Small Queen issue; light strike dated -/FE 13/95
- Additional report of an inverted year in the time mark slot; on 3 cent SQ, dated 49/JU 18/-
- Additional reports of the year date reversed "49" for "94"; strike on 1 cent Gov't post card dated -/JU 22/49 and strike on 8 cent SQ dated -/JU 26/49.
- New second latest strike in Period 1; strike on 8 cent Small Queen dated -/(A)P 23/95.

Woodstock, ONT: First reported strike on an 8 cent QV Numeral; backstamp on registered cover dated -/JA 12/99. Cover has additional Montreal 1892 precursor backstamp.
