YARMOUTH, NOVA SCOTIA HAMMER 2 DUAL FRANKING COVER TO ENGLAND

The cover below, with the 5 cent United States postage and 1 cent Small Queen issues, was offered in Eastern Auction's April 2025 auction. The cover, listed as Lot 629, sold for \$950.

The lot description, as it appeared in the catalog (with editing) is included below.

Yarmouth Ferry Cover to England, Via Boston. 1895 cover via Yarmouth Ferry to Boston and then by ship to Liverpool, bearing pair and single 1c Small Queen, tied by Yarmouth OC 30 95; US 5c brown applied in Yarmouth and cancelled in Boston, sent by ship to catch an earlier trans-Atlantic sailing, paid the 5c UPU rate... Postmarked on arrival with neat Liverpool US Packet 9 NO 95 CDS in red.



THE STORY BEHIND THE SCHREIBER ONT STATE 2 FAVOUR STRIKES



This sheet of favour strikes of the Schreiber State 2 squared circle hammer was offered in Sparks Auction's February 2017 sale of Ted Kerzner's collection.

The provenance of this piece includes Frank Campbell, Graham Noble and Ted Kerzner.

The handwritten notation on the piece by Schreiber Postmaster Peter Halonen reads:

"Note from strikes forwarded herewith that the instrument has not been used since 8 Dec 26 but is still held at this office. Your circular was interesting and informative"

A note accompanying the auction lot provides insight into how Frank Campbell acquired the favour strikes.

"According to (Graham) Noble, Campbell told him that many collectors (once squared circles became popularized) wrote for favour strikes once it was learned that the hammer was still in the post office.

The postmaster ignored these requests. Campbell, cleverly, sent the postmaster a note about the history of this post office. The postmaster apparently appreciated this and reciprocated with this piece.

The hammer was never returned to the Post Office, and is believed to have been lost in the fire which destroyed the old Schreiber post office."
